

Today I learned... Jesus loves us and knows our names.

Help me learn this:

Ask me:

- How did the good shepherd take care of his sheep?
- How does Jesus take care of you?
- Does Jesus know the names of everyone in our family? What else does Jesus know about our family?

Family Fun

- Check out a baby-names book from your local library. Talk with your child about why you chose his or her name and what it means.
- Play a guessing game with your family's voices. Blindfold one person, and then have everyone else take turns saying that person's name. Then have the blindfolded person guess who said his or her name. Explain that sheep know their shepherd's voice just as we know the voices of people we love.
