Today's Unreached/Least Reached People Group (LRP): Chris and Angela Hiebert and their kids left BC Jan. 3 for Mexico City to work with church planting among the urban professionals there. This group has been identified as an LRP group and we can pray for spiritual and cultural chains to be broken and that God will open their eyes and set them free from bondage because they understand Jesus' life and death for them.
