



From the Pastor

There are two main reasons for taking a moment in our service to take up the offering. Our staff, Deacons, and Stewardship Team have discussed how giving your offering is an act of worship. In the Westminster Dictionary of Theological Terms, Donold McKim defines worship as "the service of praise, adoration, thanksgiving, and petition directed toward God through actions and attitudes" (307). We believe that giving your offering is a service of thanksgiving directed towards God is an action. While you may perform this worship through giving online or dropping your envelope in the offering box, we want to provide another opportunity as part of our corporate worship service.

The second main reason, and probably our most valued reason, is for discipleship. In Deuteronomy 6:4-9, the Deuteronomist writes:

⁴"Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. ⁵You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. ⁶ And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. ⁷You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. 8 You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ⁹You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates. (ESV)

Discipleship is an action that takes place day after day. In Matthew 28, when Jesus calls us to make disciples, the word for "Go" can be translated "As you are going." Our staff, Deacons, and Stewardship Team believe this is an excellent opportunity to disciple the next generation in the importance of giving to the Lord, including financially.

A final question I want to address concerns other ways to give. I have been asked if that will be the only way to give. The answer is a simple, "No." You will continue to be able to give online. You will still be able to place your offering in the offering boxes located throughout our building. This is just another opportunity for you to give as a part of our corporate worship experience. I am excited about this opportunity to reincorporate this act of corporate worship back into our services.
