# DHBC Ministry Moment

From the Pastor

Grant Stegall



Today seems like a good opportunity to talk about the church. According to The Baptist Faith and Message 2000, Southern Baptists recognize two ordinances. Don't misunderstand this, there are more than two ministries, but only two ordinances. What is the difference? An ordinance is a practice that Christ "ordained" that helps one identify with the death of Christ. I also want to explain the differences in ordinances and sacraments. Millard Erickson defines a sacrament as, "A religious rite regarded as a means or sign of grace." This means that a person performs these rites to receive grace. An ordinance is not a means of grace but rather an act of obedience that helps the person, as stated before, identify with the death of Christ.

At DHBC, we recognize two ordinances: baptism and the Lord's Supper. Last week, I had the opportunity to baptize my youngest child, Esther Kate. It was a special time for the Stegall family. But let's look at the baptism. The baptism will help Esther Kate, or whoever is baptized, to identify with the death and the resurrection of Christ, because it is a picture of what happens in our lives when we trust Christ. When I baptize someone, I quote part of Romans 6:4, "We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life" (ESV). As Baptists, we don't hold that baptism saves us. In Ephesians 2:8-9, Paul writes, "For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God not a result of works, so that no one may boast" (ESV). Salvation is a gift of God given to us by the grace of God, accepted through faith. If baptism were required for salvation, that would be a work of man. Instead, we are baptized out of obedience to help us identify with the death and resurrection of Christ.

Today we are recognizing the second ordinance of the church: the Lord's Supper. Christ instituted the Lord's Supper at his last Passover meal. At this meal, he took the bread, broke it, and said, "This is my body, which is given for you, Do this in remembrance of me." Then he took the cup and gave it to them likewise. Some believe that the bread and the wine/juice become the actual blood and flesh of Jesus. Instead, we believe that they symbolize the blood and flesh, and we partake out of obedience to Christ and help us remember his death. As we celebrate either ordinance, baptism or the Lord's Supper, I want to encourage you to do so with reverence, meditating on the death and resurrection of our Lord, Jesus Christ. Ponder the price He paid for us on the cross and the victory He brought us in the resurrection.

Finally, I want to encourage you to continue in your reading of God's Word. I am currently in Deuteronomy. Believe me, I know sometimes the reading can seem tedious, but continue. God promises in Isaiah 55:11, "so shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it." Continue reading, knowing that God's purpose in His word in your life will help you find success.
