INTRODUCTION

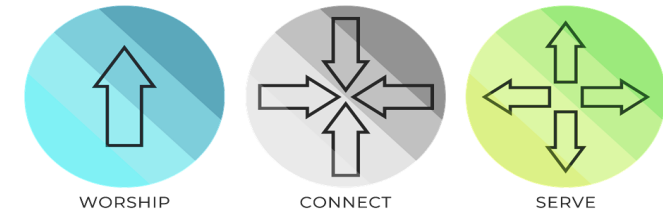
