

What is it?

Family Camp is an opportunity for everyone in the church family to relax, play, eat, swim, sing, and learn together in a scenic setting in the Rocky Mountains on the Dearborn River.

Expectations

The only expectation of the weekend is that you have a relaxing time of fun with your family, the church, and God. There will be plenty of free time to enjoy this weekend away!



Housing

Each family will be housed in quadcabins equipped with bunk beds. Bathhouses are located in separate buildings close to the cabins.

Teaching & Fellowship

We'll share a time of teaching on Saturday and Sunday mornings, giving you lots of free time in the afternoons to explore our beautiful surroundings, play some games, or spend time relaxing by the pool. We will have campfires each night with s'mores. Saturday night we also have our annual Talent Show! Come ready to share your skills.



What to Bring

Bibles, swimsuits, towels, toiletries, warm clothes, fishing gear, sports equipment, sleeping bags, pillows, games, guitars, extra money for the C-N snack shack, etc.

Travel

Many will travel as families to camp, but we can also do some car-pooling. If you would like to ride with others or are willing to take extra passengers, please contact the church office or make note of it on the sign-up sheet.



Cost

The cost for camp is \$99 per adult (18+). Children attend camp free of charge. Costs include 2 nights lodging, 6 meals, and full facility usage. Please pay in the church office or through the online form found on our mobile app or website by Friday, July 2. *(Make checks out to Life Covenant Church with a memo saying Family Camp.)* If you are not staying for the entire weekend, or would like to visit for a day with or without meals, please call the office for pro-rated pricing. Financial assistance is available, so please call Lynnette Sena in the church office.



Arrival & Departure

You may arrive after 4:30pm on Friday, July 9. We will begin with supper at 6:30pm. Then you can unpack, get a feel for the camp layout, and enjoy the facilities!

We will leave after clean-up on Sunday, July 11, before 2:30pm.

Directions (From Helena):

(Find it on Google Maps as Montana Wilderness School of the Bible.)

- Take I-15 North to the Hwy 287 Exit.
- Travel 287, crossing Hwy 200.
- Continue NW on 287, 4 miles past Hwy 200 and take a left onto the gravel (Flat Creek Rd).
- Travel 8 miles on the gravel and then take a left turn at the Y (remaining on Flat Creek/ Dearborn Canyon Rd).
- Travel another 9 miles (crossing Hwy 434/435, passing Bean Lake and Diamond Bar X) and you will arrive at our gate.

C-N Camp Rules

- The use of alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs are never allowed on C-N property.
- 2) No fireworks or firearms are allowed on C-N property.
- Dress and grooming are to be within the bounds of modesty and good taste, as determined by C-N staff and the guest director.
- 4) A campfire is permitted at the fireside circle and must be conducted under the supervision of an adult staff person.
- 5) Conduct on the part of all guests at C-N is to be in a decent and morally acceptable manner.
- Do not litter, pick flowers, carve on trees, or interfere with wildlife on C-N grounds.
- 7) Do not remove any eating utensils from the dining hall.
- 8) Food and beverages are not allowed in the upstairs of the Chapel.
- 9) No pets of any kind are allowed on C-N grounds.
- 10) As of now, masks are optional not required.
