# **GUIDELINES**

As stewards of the children during their time abroad, we make every effort to keep them healthy, safe and to maintain their African culture. We appreciate your respect of the following guidelines:

Please do not expose them to anything with a screen (computers, TV, video games, etc.) or anything that has wheels or requires balance (bikes, roller skates, trampolines, etc.)

To support their dental care, please no candy, chocolate or soda.

Though we reserve their concert music for the stage performances, you might enjoy joining them in a worship song before bedtime.

Feel free to ask them about Africa in general, but please refrain from asking about their personal

The children love hugs, but no kisses please.

Please be sensitive that the children may have a legitimate fear of animals. Please introduce them to your animals slowly.

## SCHEDULE

Due to the nature of tour life, staying on schedule is very important. Thank you for helping us by adhering to the following:

### 7:30 pm | Shower Time

Please show them the towels, facecloth, soap &

Please give them their privacy and allow them to shower independently

### 8:00 pm | Bed Time

Please leave a light on to the bathroom

Children with a history of bed wetting will have pull-ups, but we recommend you cover your mattress (large trash bags work well)

### Morning Routine

The children need 1 hour & 15 minutes to get ready.

PLEASE NOTE: The chaperone may have their day off during their time with you. Special arrangements for this are not required but may be offered (staying at your home to rest, being dropped off at the mall or movie etc).
