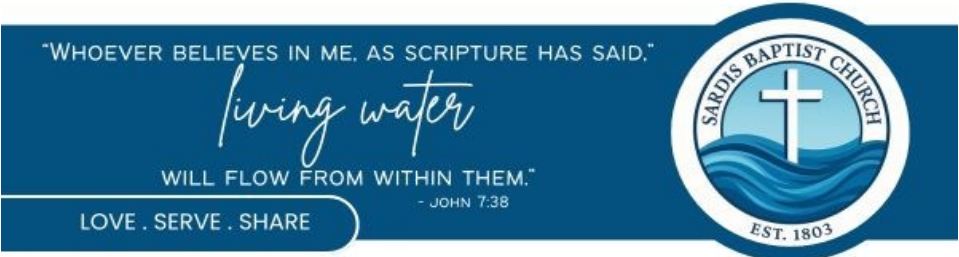
You May Join Sardis Baptist Church
