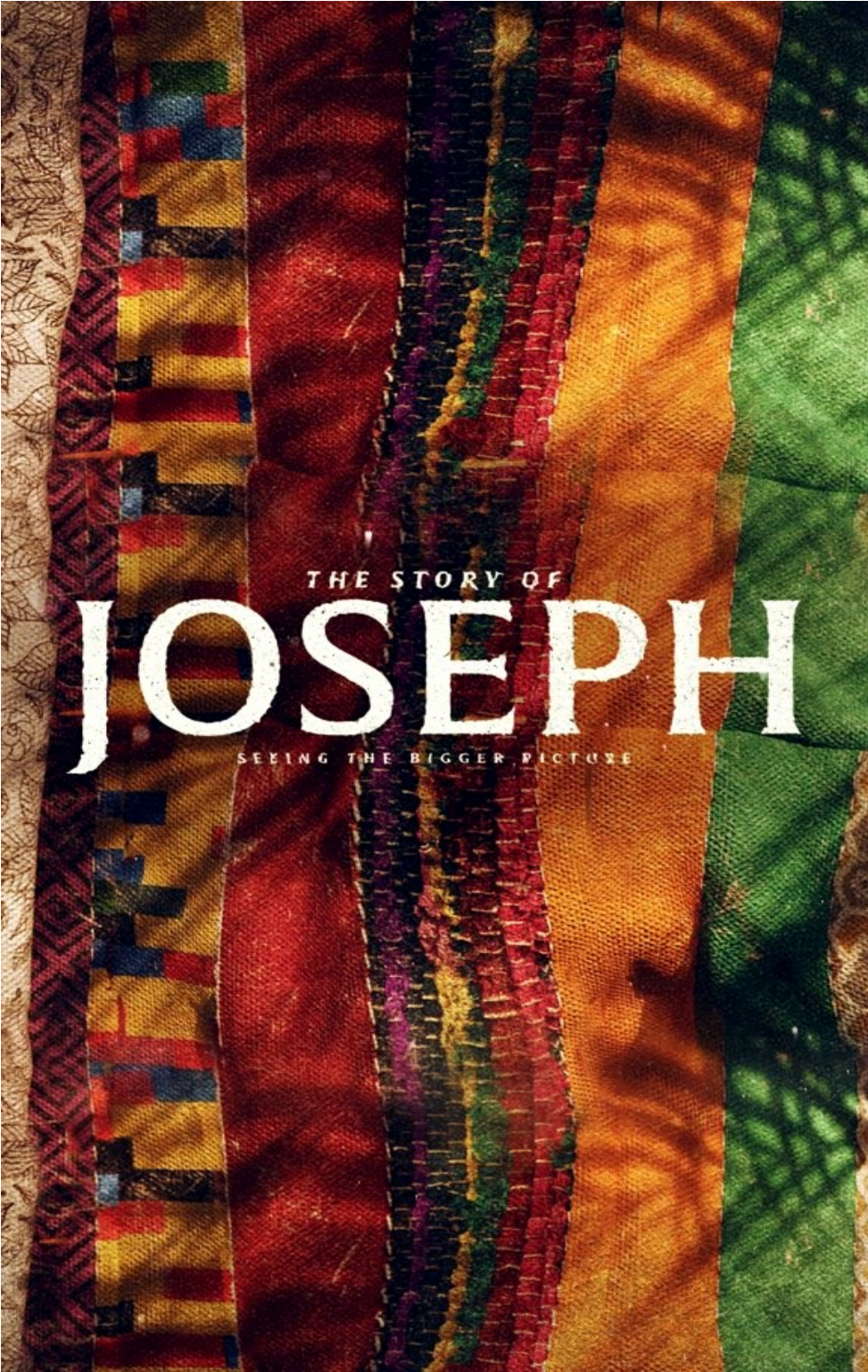

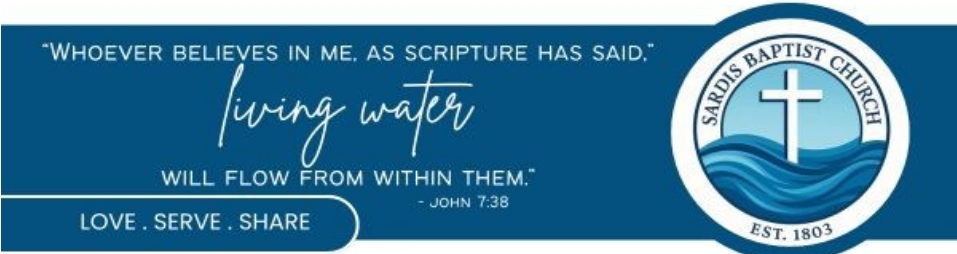
You May Join
