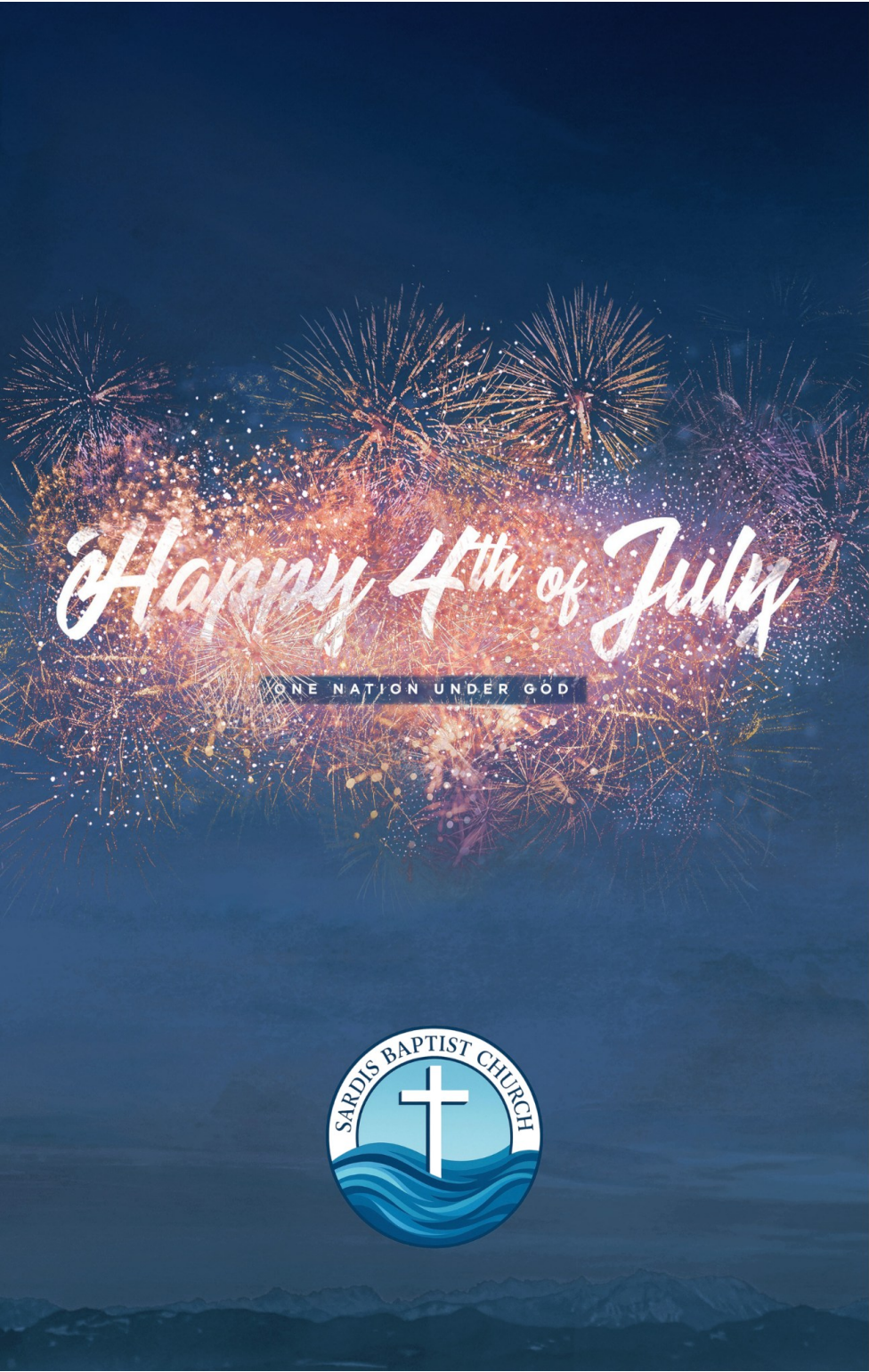

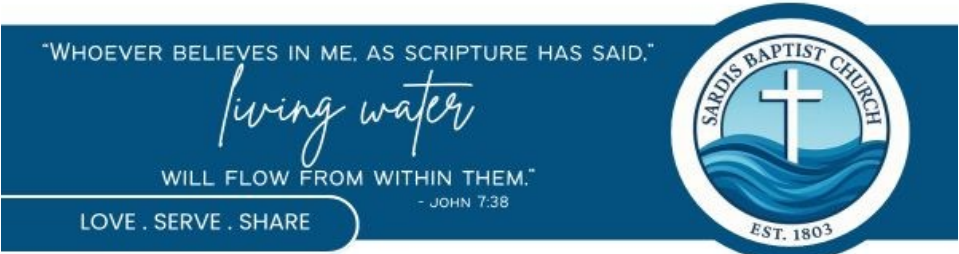
You May Join

- ♦ **By Believer's Baptism**
