

# ENGAGING IN WORSHIP

**GROWING**IN GROUPS

**SERVING** IN MINISTRY



The Holy Spirit is discounted and overlooked by evangelical believers (especially the Baptists!) even though He is the third person of the Trinity. One reason for this neglect is confusion. There is no systematic description of the Spirit anywhere in Scripture, which means we must put all the pieces together and synthesize them into a coherent portrait. This is a difficult and daunting task. Many Bible teachers have focused on other things, leaving us with lots of unanswered questions about the Holy Spirit.

Another reason for this lack of attention is a focus on practical Christianity. Topical sermons, hands-on studies, and how-to podcasts are hot these days. Everyone seems interested in improving their Christian walk in a concrete way. There is certainly nothing wrong with this, but it leaves things like the doctrine of the Holy Spirit in the back of the closet with little to no attention.

A final reason for this gap is fear. The excesses of the modern Pentecostal and charismatic movements have caused some people to distance themselves from the Holy Spirit. Many Baptists are afraid that they will be accused of being "one of those people" if they emphasize or talk about the ministry of the third person of the Trinity. Some are also anxious about losing their focus on the second person of the Trinity, Jesus Christ.

We can correct this situation by summoning up the courage to ask the right questions. In our Wednesday night Catalyst Study, this October and November, we will be addressing "Everything You Always Wanted to Know About the Holy Spirit but Were Afraid to Ask." We will be looking at what the Bible has to say about the Holy Spirit's place in the Godhead, His activity in the Old and New Testaments, and His ministry in the world, the life of believers, and in the church. We will also be answering questions about the modern charismatic movement and how to cultivate the Spirit's power and presence today.

Our Catalyst Study is focused on helping believers build a biblical view of the world and everything in it. Over the course of the last 2 and ½ years, we have focused on most of the doctrines in the Scriptures. We have also pieced together an overview of the Old and New Testaments. We are currently engaged in a study of the disciplines to facilitate spiritual growth. All of this is a part of Northside's overall disciple-making pathway of spiritual formation and spiritual multiplication.

I hope you'll jump in and join us starting on October 1 at 6:30 PM as we ask these key questions together!




# **Northside Youth Ministry Essentials**


Also in September, we had our Nerf and Hide & Seek event at the church. This was an awesome time of fel-

# I Would Die for You: One Student's Story of Passion, Service and Faith


This book about young missionary, BJ Higgins, is now available in our Family Resource Library (upstairs in the CLC). Not only is it challenging and inspiring, but the book, "I Would Die for You" is also very personal to Northside Baptist Church. Written by Brent and Deanna Higgins, the story is more than a story. If you've been around Northside long enough, you've experienced it first-hand.

Brent and Deanna were members of Northside in 1989 when their son, BJ (Brent Allen Higgins, Jr.) was born on October 1st that year. As a newborn, BJ played the role of Baby Jesus in Northside's Christmas pageant while his mom and dad played Mary and Joseph. BJ grew up here. The book is full of quotes from people who knew BJ and were close to him, including many members of Northside.

In slightly less than sixteen years of life, BJ Higgins experienced a full and amazing relationship with his Savior. It was a relationship that few people realize so fully, even if they live many years. We can't second-guess God, or ask what might have been. BJ was willing to die to further God's kingdom.

From a personal perspective, I remember hearing that BJ had become ill. It was August of 2005 and I knew he had just returned from his second mission to Peru. He had contracted a serious respiratory illness. Northside members were asked not to visit the hospital and overwhelm the family. During that time, my son Jeff called me and said he had been asked to set up a blog for the family so friends and church family could stay up to date on BJ's condition. Blogs were not so commonplace back then, but this one became a phenomenon, especially after MercyMe, Northside's longstanding "camp band" shared the link on their prayer page. People around the globe were logging into the blog every day to check BJ's status and to see how to pray for him. I read the updates every morning, crying and praying and being inspired by excerpts from the journals of a very godly teenager.





When BJ died, it brought some things to light that we otherwise might not have seen or understood. This book, the blog (prayforbj.com), the memorial service and even the calling upon his parents' life were all letting us see God at work. He is moving in this generation. He is raising up young people who will go where he sends them.

BJ's memorial service, here at Northside, concluded with young people flooding to the front of the auditorium saying, "I will take BJ's place" (on the mission field). That event reminded me of Jesus' words in the book of John when He said, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit. He who loves his life loses it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it to life eternal. If anyone serves Me, he must follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also; if anyone serves Me, the Father will honor him. (John 12:23-26 NASB)
