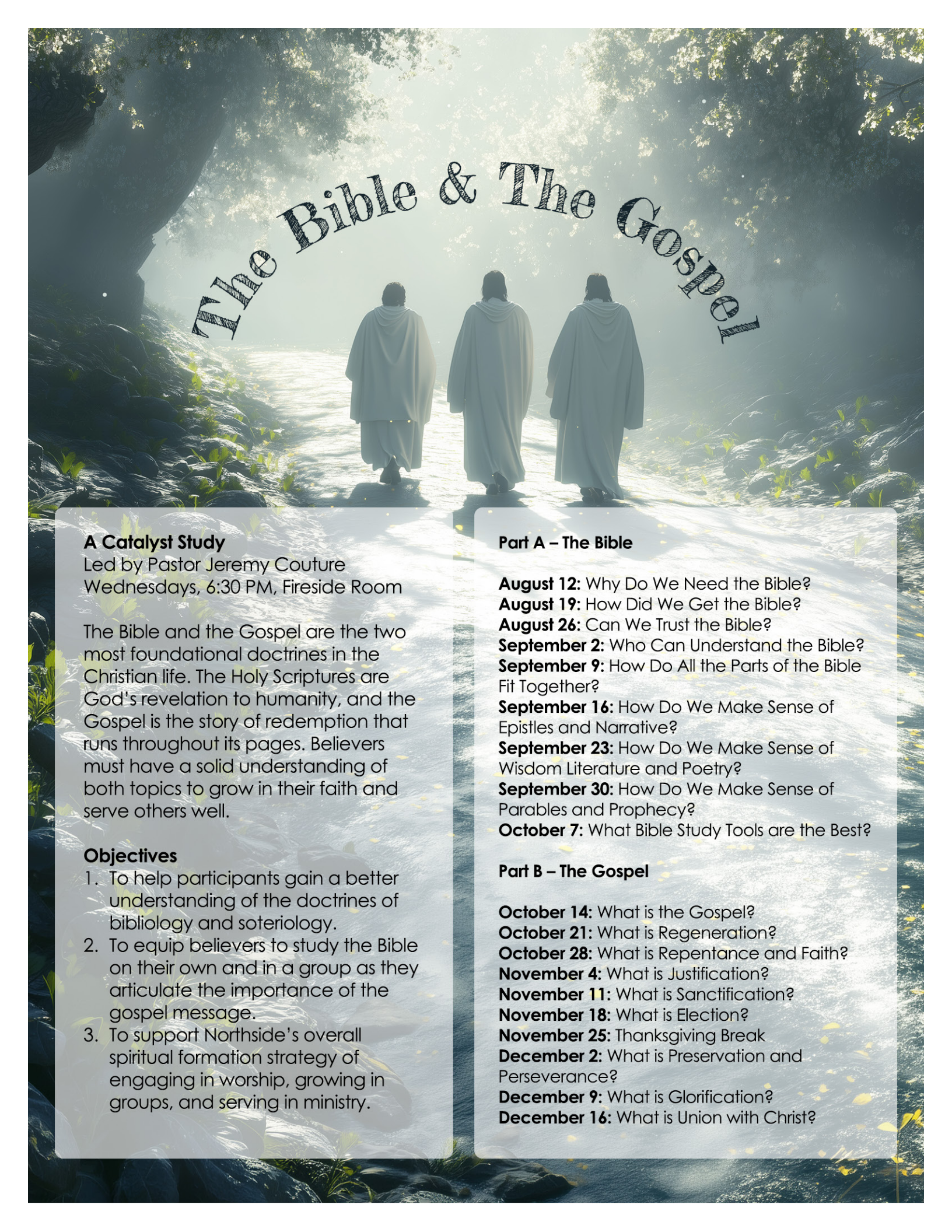




The Bible & The Gospel
