


This Sunday night our youth will join with other Presbyterian youth groups in the area for a night of service at Faith Pres!

Thank Offering 2025 - November 23, 2025

"Behold I am doing a new thing, now it springs forth, do you not perceive it. I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert". Isaiah 43:19 (rev).

On Sunday, November 23 the congregation of Fellowship Presbyterian Church will have the opportunity to participate in the Thank Offering. A Thank offering envelope will be included in the Sunday bulletin.

The Thank Offering program was begun in 1888 in Ohio when Eliza Clokey called upon women to give a thank offering to the Lord. Through the years, thousands of people have benefitted through programs which have received support through Thank Offering grants from Presbyterian Women and congregations. \$257,897 was raised to support a total of 10 grant applications this year. Projects funded included Homestead Presbytery - support for Sleep in Heavenly Peace - in Nebraska, Presbytery of the Peaks - Roanoke Justice Ministries in Lexington, Virginia and Grace Presbytery Community Garden Kitchen of Collins County, Texas. FOLLOW ME





"FOLLOW ME" is boldly stitched across the bottom of the banner that is presently hanging on the front of our Pulpit. Hopefully, this action phrase reminds us each Sunday as we look at it, that we are made in the image of God and that He sent His Son, Jesus Christ, to show us the path of life He has planned uniquely for each us.

The banners that hang from the pulpit in a church are called paraments. They tell a story of the church seasons, such as: Advent, Lent, Pentecost and each is filled with meaningful symbols. The banner that is presently hanging from our pulpit depicts what is called "Ordinary Time". It is covers the longest period of time on the calendar.

Ordinary Time banners are always green to symbolize our growth in Christ's teachings and the renewal that takes place throughout our faith journey as we confess our sins, repent of our wrong doings and are continually renewed by God's grace.

The gold on the cross and around the outer border represents God's and Jesus' rich, everlasting, unbreakable promises to each of us. The crimson in the border represents the blood Jesus shed for us on the cross that washes away our sins.

The Cross, of course, symbolizes Jesus' crucifixion and reminds us of His amazing resurrection.

The cross-hatch stitching behind the cross reminds us that God is always present (like a safety net, if we'll allow Him to be) and that He wants us to be drawing others' to Him like fishermen in His day and time drew fish in with a net.

As you get closer to our banner, you will see that the path to salvation is stitched out along with the Fruit of the Spirt, as well as some of the life-giving instructions Jesus told us to follow, such as: to forgive and to remember to sprinkle grace wherever we go!

The outer border reminds us of God's most compelling promise: "I will never leave you, or forsake you." (Hebrews 13:6)

My prayer throughout the time I was designing and making this banner for our church was that it will encourage each of us to seek to draw closer to God, to live more in Jesus' image and to allow the living presence of the Holy Spirit to shape our lives on a daily basis.
