## Thriving Congregations

Fellowship Presbyterian was invited to join with nearly 30 other vibrant churches throughout the country to participate in an initiative called Thriving Congregations. It is funded entirely through a grant from Eli Lily. The purpose is to lead churches to look toward the future to identify how they want to grow by setting new ways to serve each other and our community while keeping those things that we are already doing well. The first step is to ge to know each other better through 1 to 1 conversations. We have set a goal of 80 conversations with members and regular visitors to our church. We want to know you personally, why you joined or began coming to FPC, what brought you here, and why you stay. The second phase is to hold at least 5 small group meetings for you to help identify what needs to be kept, and your ideas and dreams about ways to serve each other and our community. The third phase is implementation of the ideas we as a congregation have identified.
