### **Financial Peace University Wednesdays Starting January 24th, 7:00 p.m., Cranmer Room**

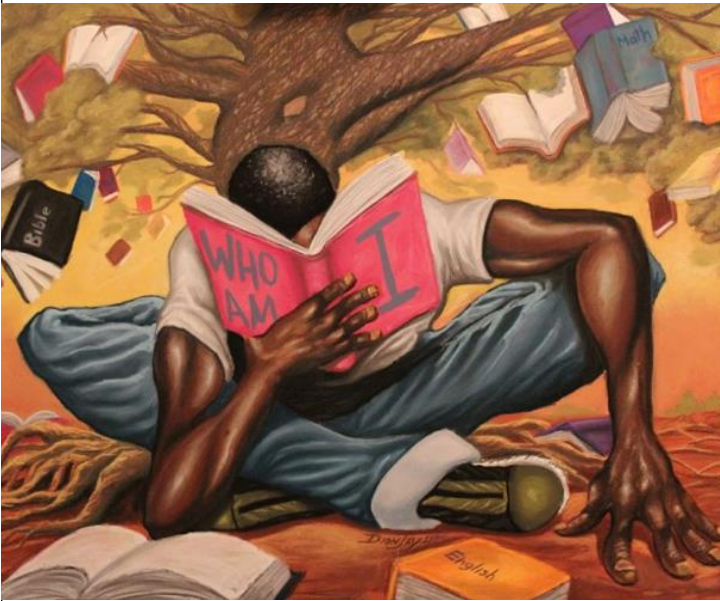
