## Vendor Regulations:

1. **Each Space is \$30/40/50 each** – Based on size and location. All proceeds from space rentals support our Children's Ministry.
2. **Additional Vendor Purchases** - \$15 for an 8ft table rental from the church, \$10 for a breakfast package, \$10 for a lunch package (prepared by our youth for fundraising)
3. **Spots are reserved on a first-come, first-served basis.** Please visit our website to reserve your space before turning in this form: [spumchou.org/garagesale](http://spumchou.org/garagesale)
4. **All spaces must be paid in full at least 24 hours before the event.**
5. **There are NO REFUNDS after 4/12/2026.**
6. **Setup is from 7am until 8:30am.** Please do not be late! If no vendor has shown up by 8:30am to claim a space, it will be offered to neighboring vendors. This is to eliminate awkward gaps in the sales area.
7. **Vehicles are not allowed in the sales area.** You will be able to enter the sales area and unload your items between 6-8am and then you must move your vehicle to the designated parking area. Vehicles will not be allowed in the sales area after 8:00am when pedestrians start showing up. This policy will be strictly enforced. If

you are in a grass area, you must travel between your vehicle and your vendor area. Please be prepared or bring a cart to assist with unloading.

8. **You are responsible for the items you bring.** The church cannot be held accountable for any lost/stolen items, though we will try to help you as much as we can if there is a problem. We have never had this issue occur in the past. Please make sure you are always attending your booth.
9. **You must remove all items and trash from church property before leaving.** You will not be able to dump any unwanted items into our dumpster. We will have small trash cans available for paper and food item waste, but we politely ask you to take everything else with you.
10. **You CANNOT SELL the following items:** drugs, alcohol, firearms/explosives/weapons of any kind, profane material or media, or anything else we deem inappropriate. Please keep these event family friendly.
11. **Vendors should be aware of nature and the elements:** Depending on which spot you picked - you may be in the sun or in the shade. The grass might be wet with dew early in the morning. Please plan to bring tents for shade or a tarp to lay down in your area if needed.

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## **Vendors - what should you bring?**

- **You will need to bring a folding table** to display your merchandise if you don't want to lay things on the ground. 8 ft Tables can be rented from the church for an additional \$15
- **Plenty of small bills (\$)** or a **card reader for transactions.** We usually have 300+ shoppers come to our annual sales, and you don't want to run out of money - so please bring as much petty cash as you can.
- **A tent or canopy for shade.** Shaded spots ARE NOT guaranteed at the event.
- **A large tarp or mat.** The grass vendor areas might be wet from morning dew.
- **A dolly or cart** to move your items from your car to your vending area.
- **A garbage bag** to dispose of your trash that you can take with you when you leave so that we do not fill up our church dumpster. We thank everyone in advance for their consideration.
- **Bring water bottles and containers** to stay hydrated. We do have a water fountain on campus.
- **Sunscreen/Bug Spray/Sunglasses/Hats/Jackets/Good Shoes**
