For a number of years, First Lutheran has been blessed with the opportunity to partner with the Lutheran Church of South Sudan. South Sudan has been a country with a difficult history of internal conflict, tribalism, and even genocide. Millions of their people are now refugees outside the borders of South Sudan. In spite of this difficult context, the Lutheran Church of South Sudan continues to grow and flourish.

In 2019, we were blessed to be able to provide funds for a water well at the main campus of Trinity College in Gambella, not far from a very large refugee camp. This past fall, we were able to wire funds for a second water well at the Itang Branch of Trinity College. Other projects have been supported as well.

On Sunday, March 24, Pastor Jordan Long, President of the Lutheran Church of South Sudan, will be here for his third time. He will be sharing and giving an update on the water wells and what the Lord is doing through the Lutheran Church of South Sudan.

There will also be a special presentation 9:30 AM, between the services. A potluck meal in his honor will follow the second service. All are welcome!
