This year's Baptism of Our Lord Sunday will be special. First, as Jesus chose to be identified with us in baptism, all the worshipers will have an opportunity to publicly say "Yes!" to their baptism in Christ Jesus. There is nothing more important you will ever say than "Yes!" to Jesus.

SUNDAYS, JAN. 18 THROUGH MARCH 22 — "GENUINE CHRISTIANITY"

What does real Christianity look like when beliefs are challenged, love grows cold, and truth is blurred? The letters of **1**, **2**, and **3** John were written to communities facing many of the same pressures we face today—confusion about Jesus, competing loyalties, false teachers, and strained relationships within the church. John writes not to offer abstract theology, but to call God's people back to what is real, faithful, and life-giving.

From Jan. 18 through March 22, we will have a preaching series called "Genuine Christianity". We will explore a faith rooted in the truth about Jesus, lived out by walking in the light, expressed through love, and guarded against deception. These letters press us to ask honest questions: *Do we believe the truth? Are we living it? Are we loving as God loves?* Week by week, John gives us clear tests of authentic faith and a compelling picture of the kind of church that is worth writing about.
