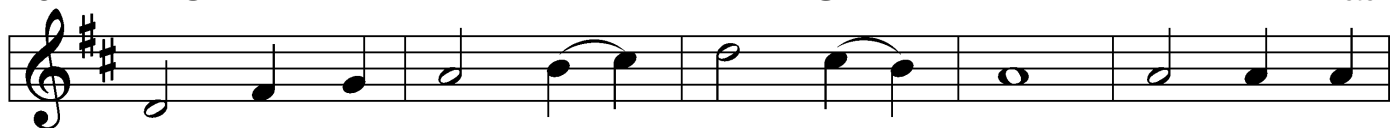
AS WE GATHER - MARKED FOR THE CLIMB

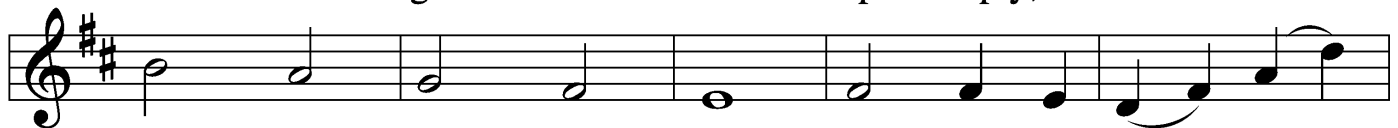

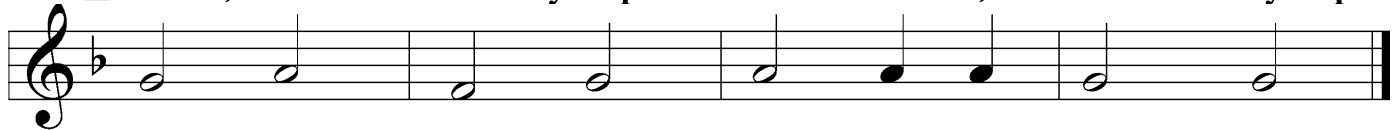



REMEMBRANCE OF BAPTISM
