Grace Christian School is Saginaw's only non-denominational Christian school. We are a ministry of Grace Baptist Church with a student body that represents several area churches.

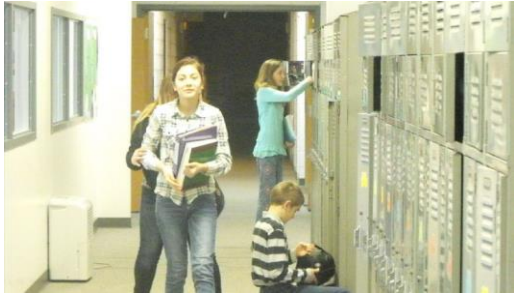

Academics

Our English/language arts, an A Beka curriculum, includes a strong grammar program with spelling, literature, and writing.

Sixth grade math is a continuation of the ABeka program that is begun in the elementary grades, while seventh and eighth graders transition into pre-algebra. This fairly rigorous program meets the benchmarks typical of an Algebra I class.

Christian Schools International supplies our science curriculums. Interesting, hands-on labs every week coupled with a wide variety of activities appeal to many different learning styles.

Standardized Testing

Each spring students K-8 take nationally-normed standardized tests. We do not take the Michigan M-step mostly because it is written to state benchmarks (core curriculum) that is not part of our curriculum.

Bible Classes and Service Projects

Bible is taught at all age levels. Middle school Bible rotates on a three-year cycle that includes worldviews, Old and New Testament surveys and the life of Christ. Our service projects put into action the love we have in Christ.

Electives.

We offer students several electives, some of which rotate on a 2-3 year cycle. Keyboarding, Office Applications, Art, Cooking and Baking, Spanish I, PE, and financial literacy.

Technology. We have a computer lab with touch-screen all-in-one HP computers. Teachers are encouraged to use the lab at least once a week.
