Policies and Procedures: Council Structure

Youth Advisory Council (YAC) is the youth component of Healthy Choices Caring Communities (community coalition focused on preventing and reducing youth substance abuse). It serves as an advisory board to the general coalition in planning and implementing youth related activities.

In addition to the Leadership Team, the Youth Advisory Council will also select a number of Family Group leaders, depending on the size of the council and level of interest, to serve as the leaders of YAC's family groups.

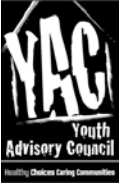
Family Group Leader

- Any YAC member is eligible for position
- Must be able to attend 80% of meetings
- Must attend Family Group meeting prior to YAC general meeting (15 minutes prior to scheduled meeting)
- Must attend "post-mortem" meeting following YAC general meeting (15 minutes)

Selection Process:

- Members interested in serving as a family group leader will submit an interest letter by May meeting.
- Selection will be made by YAC staff as well as HC3 coalition members.
- Preference will be given to those YAC members who have participated in state or national level youth prevention training opportunities.
