**FCA Camp Information:** FCA stands for Fellowship of Christian Athletes. Teams have multiple "chapel sessions" each day, which are like church services. They compete against the other 14 schools there on the field between the church services. Kids stay in the dorm rooms and eat at LR's cafeteria. The camp was June 11-13 at Lenoir-Rhyne College. Cost is \$200/per kid. Usually FCA pays for it all through scholarships. This year, due to Hurricane Helene, they were not able to financially support us.

Our total cost is right at \$7,400. We are reaching out to local churches for any financial support that they would be willing to give.

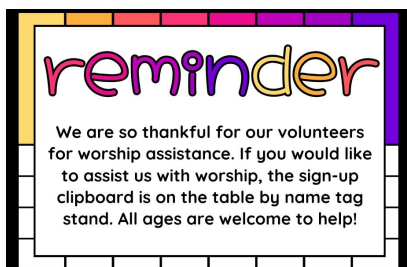
