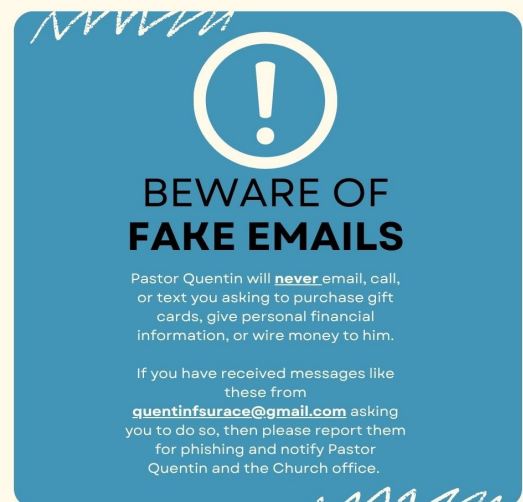

CITIZEN REASSURANCE PROGRAM PRESENTATION

What it is:

The Claremont Police Department's mission is to provide the highest quality of police service to the citizens of our community. In that spirit, a program called the Citizen Reassurance Program has been developed to allow our staff to reach out to our senior and disabled citizens to check on their safety and wellbeing. Participants must be a resident of Claremont, NC, an older adult, or adults with a disability, who lives alone or who are at risk of sudden illness, falls, accidents, and/or social isolation.

Department staff will contact the participants on Tuesdays and Thursdays via telephone beginning at 10:00 a.m. to check on a participant's welfare. If telephone contact cannot be made after two unanswered telephone calls, a Claremont police officer will be dispatched to the participant's residence and conduct a welfare check.
