

LENT AND HOLY WEEK 2024—GUIDED TO THE CROSS

To: Members of St. Mark's Lutheran Church

From: Rev. Dr. Ted Rust and the Worship Team

Grace to you, peace, and joy in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. I want to inform you about some of our plans for Lent and Holy Week this year. "GUIDED TO THE CROSS" is our theme. During the season of Lent we are guided by faith to the cross of Jesus where he died to save us from sin and death forever. We are guided to many things when we go to the cross. Forgiveness, hope, love, peace, trust, and perseverance are some of the most treasured blessings we receive when we reach the foot of the Lord's cross. So much of the Christian life is centered around these concepts that propel us ever forward in our Christian faith. Devotions for each family will be handed out at the Ash Wednesday Services and these are special Devotions for youth.

- 1. February 14-Ash Wednesday Services at 12:30pm and 7:30pm. Lunch serve t 1:15pm. The Sermon Title is "Guided to Forgiveness." (Colossians 1:13-14). When we confess our sins, we find forgiveness in the cross of Christ and empowered to forgive others.
- February 20-Tuesday Service at 12:30pm. Lunch served at 1:15pm. The Sermon Title is "Guided to Hope."
 (Corinthians 1:10) When we are uncertain about what the future holds, we discover in the cross the sure hope of heaven.
- 3. February 27-Tuesday Service at 12:30pm. Lunch served at 1:15pm. The Sermon Title is "Guided to Love." (Timothy 1:13-14) When we are separated from others and from God by our sin, the cross brings us together through its love.
- 4. March 5-Tuesday Service at 12:30pm. Lunch served at 1:15pm. The Sermon Title is "Guided to Peace." (Colossians 1:19-20) With wars waging within and without, the Cross settles them all with peace to body, mind, and soul.
- 5. March 12-Tuesday Service at 12:30pm. Lunch served at 1:15pm. The Sermon Title is "Guided to Trust." (Timothy 1:15) Plagued by doubt and competing voices, we turn to the Cross to put our trust fully in salvation won for us there.
- 6. March 19-Tuesday Service at 12:30pm. Lunch served at 1:15pm. The Sermon Title is "Guided to Perseverance." (Ephesians 6:18) When we are faced with hardship, we look to Jesus on the Cross who endured to the end so that we might carry on.
- 7. March 28-Maundy Thursday Service at 6:30pm. Sermon Title is "Guided to Service." (Romans 7:6) With water and basin and wine and bread, Jesus shows that he is a servant who gives his all for us, even death on the Cross.
- 8. March 29-Good Friday Service at 6:30pm. Sermon Title is "Guided to Sacrifice." (Hebrews 10:12) Jesus took our place on the cross, offering himself for us that we might offer ourselves as living sacrifices to him.
- 9. March 31-Easter Sunday Service at 10:00am. The Sermon Title is "Guided to New Life." (Romans 6:4) The empty tomb reveals the power of the crucified Christ to break through the bonds of death to live again that we might live forever.

You may sign up for a particular Sunday by calling the church office or the flower calendar is on the wall right outside the church office, you may sign up there. Any questions please call the office.




