In 1 Corinthians 12, it says, "Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of services, but the same Lord; and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone. To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. To one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance

of knowledge according to the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the discernment of spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. All these are activated by one and the same Spirit, who allots to each one individually just as the Spirit chooses. For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. "

Over the last few months I am have been encouraged by the movement of the Spirit within the people of St. Mark's. I have witnessed people, disciples, trying new things and doing new things for our faith community. People who did not sing in the choir before sang on Good Friday and Easter morning. People have answered yes to serving on ministry teams including congregation council and our new Safety team. Others have begun helping to take communion and contact our homebound members and those at assisted living facilities. The parts of the body of Christ are working and moving and making a difference not only within the walls of the church but also outside the walls within our community.

This next Sunday, April 16, and in the weeks to come, we will be taking a closer look at what part of the body of Christ each of us is being called and have already been given the abilities to serve our Lord. As we discern, which means to be attentive to God so we might come to sense God's heart and purpose so we may align ourselves to whatever God is doing and calling us to do and be, we will be having conversations and spending time in prayer listening to God's call to us. God spoke to Moses through the burning bush, and God has already and will continue to talk to us in the way in which we will best be able to hear God's voice.

I ask that you prayerfully consider spending time in prayer and reading scripture each day over the next 4 weeks listening and looking for the movement of the Holy Spirit around you. Come to worship which is where as disciples and believers we can be in community learning and listening to God in the scriptures, songs, prayer, and silence. You are a part of the body of Christ and each part of the body is needed for the body to function and live as it was designed. Know that I am praying for you and asking God to make God's self known to you and to what purpose God is calling and asking of you. Our call to communal discipleship

## LORD, COULD WE PLEASE JUST HAVE A BURNING BUSH?



If you heard the Temple Talks the last two Sundays, you are aware of our need for a Burning Bush. But maybe, just maybe, there are burning bushes everywhere around us. Why don't we see them? Why don't we feel the heat radiating from their presence? Why don't we hear them popping and cracking and smell the smoke that wafts in the air? Maybe we aren't looking, listening, or even praying for them.

Somehow we aren't getting the memo from God who speaks through our neighbors, who sends signs and smoke signals every moment of our lives, and who gives us holy surprises. If we can quiet the personal agendas in our minds to see how our mission can play out in the world, if we ask the right questions without anticipating the answer we think it "should" be, if we "seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, then all these things will be added to you."
