What You Need

- ☐ Mylar heart balloon, one per Small Group
- ☐ Plastic straw

Inclusive Pro Tips

Select moves that are suitable for everyone in the group. Movements can be done sitting if that is best for the group.

(1) What You Do

Before the Activity

- 1. Use the straw to inflate the balloon with air.
- 2. The mylar will self-seal once blown up and the straw is removed.

During the Activity

1. Hit or toss the balloon in the air and encourage children to do a movement before the balloon hits the ground.

After the Activity

Introduce the Bible Story.

② What You Say

Before the Activity

"Friends, I have a fun game to play with you today! Come over here and spread out."

During the Activity

"What shape is my balloon? (Pause for responses.) Yes! It's a heart! Hearts remind us of love. We've got a heart because we're going to be learning about how much God loves us! I'm going to toss the balloon in the air, and before it hits the ground, I want you to do any movement you want. You can jump, run in place, clap, dance, but whatever you do, you have to freeze when the balloon hits the ground. Are you ready to play? (Toss the balloon. If children are struggling to know what to do, call out a movement for them to do.) Oh no, hurry, it's almost to the ground, everybody freeze! (Pause.) You did it! (Pick up the balloon and toss it again.) Do a different movement this time. (Repeat as desired.) Friends, that was so fun!"

After the Activity

"Today we're going to hear how much God loves (hold up the heart balloon) us in our true story from the Bible. I can't wait to hear all about God's love! Let's go!"

Transition → Move to Worship and Story by following the balloon. Have the leader hold it up high so all children can see it, and the leader could even bop it in the air as they walk.

② What You Say

Before the Activity

"Friends, come stand with me, and let me tell you our brand-new Memory Verse! Ready to hear it? It goes like this. 'God (flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down) loved the world so much (cross arms over chest) that he gave his only Son,' (rock arms like a baby) John 3:16." (Open hands like a book.)

During the Activity

"Now, let's learn the motions. The first part of our verse says: 'God (flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down) Put one hand up straight in front of you with your thumb almost touching your forehead like this. (Straight, flat hand with thumb at your forehead.) Then move your hand straight down in front of you like this, (pull down) and say, 'God.' (Repeat with children.) Great job!

"The next part of our verse says: 'Loved the world so much.'
(Cross arms over chest.) Give yourself a hug, (hug yourself)
and say, 'loved the world so much.' (Pause.) Now let's put that
together. 'God (flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down)
loved the world so much. (cross arms over chest) Great job!

Let's pretend we are holding a baby in our arms like this (rock arms like a baby) and say 'that he gave his only Son.' (Repeat with children.) Nice job! Now let's put that together. God (flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down) loved the world so much (cross arms over chest) that he gave his only Son,' (rock arms like a baby) Super! "Now the last part is: John 3:16. (Open hands like a book.) Put your hands together in front of you and open them like you are opening a book (open hands like a book) and say: John 3:16. (Repeat with children.) Great job! I think we are ready to do it all together! Ready friends? 'God (flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down) loved the world so much (cross arms over chest) that he gave his only Son,' (rock arms like a baby) John 3:16. (Open hands like a book.) Nice job. Let's do it again!" (Repeat several times.)

After the Activity

Now put your heart on Mary and tell her the message, Mary, you're going to have a baby, His name will be Jesus. (With children.) Mary, you're going to have a baby, His name will be Jesus. Great job carrying the message to Mary!"

After the Activity

During the Activity

(Hold up the heart cutout.) Hearts make us think of love, and we learned that God loves you and God loves me SO much. God gave us Jesus to be our friend forever! Glue your cutout to the heart. (Pause.) Great! Now you can color your angels and decorate them however you want! (Pause.) Wow! Super job! Now turn them over and add this label to the heart. (Pause.) Now I'll tape a loop of ribbon to the back so you can hang your special angels like a Christmas ornament."

After the Activity

"The true story of Christmas begins with God's love for us. God loved you even before you were born! God loves us SO much; God gave us Jesus to be our friend forever!

During the Activity



Before the Activity

"Friends, come stand with me, and let's say our verse as we do the motions. Ready? 'God (flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down) loved the world so much (cross arms over chest) that he gave his only Son,' (rock arms like a baby) John 3:16. (Open hands like a book.) That was great! Now let's sit down at the table to make something special!"

During the Activity

"Look! It's a gift! Decorate the outside of your gift with the markers, stickers, and stamps. While you are decorating, let's say the words to our verse. (With children.) 'God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son,' John 3:16. Great job saying the verse with me. Wow! These gifts look so wonderfully special! But wait, open your gift and see what's inside. (Pause.) It's Jesus! Hooray! Jesus is the most wonderfully special gift because God gave us Jesus! Decorate the inside of your gift too. (Pause.) Now close your present and let's say our verse one more time with the motions. 'God (flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down) loved the world so much (cross arms over chest) that he gave his only Son,' (rock arms like a baby) John 3:16. (Open hands like a book.) Nice job."


