Gather children on a rug or in a specific area of the classroom to tell the story. Some children (especially the younger ones) June wander. That's okay. They're still listening and learning!

LEADER: "Hello, friends! I'm so happy to see you today. Come join me on the floor. Today's story from the Bible (*hold up the Bible*) is a story that Jesus told because Jesus wanted EVERYONE to know that God loves them!

"Jesus told a story about a son who took a lot of money from his father and went far away from home. He spent his money on fancy clothes and fancy food until he had no more money! Oh no! He had to get a job feeding pigs and he almost ate the pig's food because he was so hungry! Eek!

"The son knew he was wrong, so he went home and told his father he was sorry. His father ran to him and hugged him tight. The father gave him a special ring and clothes and even threw him a party because he was so happy he came home.

God loves us like the father loved his son! God loves you (*point to each child*) and you and you! And God wants us to share that love because God wants everyone to be a part of His kingdom. That means when you love others, **[Bottom Line] you can be part of God's kingdom.**"

Gather small groups of children around you at a table for toddler craft time. Depending on the size of your group, you June lead the craft two or three times. Not every child June want to participate in craft time. That's okay. Feel free to send home the craft materials for them to complete with their family.

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print "Story Book" on cardstock, one per child. Fold each child's book and write their name on the cover.

During the Activity: Encourage children to decorate each page of their book with heart stamps as you review. Clean hands as needed.

What You Say:

During the Activity: "Look! It's a story book with pictures from our story. Add a heart stamp to this front page of your book. (*Point.*) Open up your book and let's look at these pictures. (*Point to each picture as you discuss.*) This picture shows the son taking the money from his father. And this picture shows the son with fancy clothes and fancy food. And this picture shows the son with a sad face, feeding pigs. Color these pictures. (*Pause.*) Close your book and look at the back picture. It's such a happy picture! It's the father and son hugging – it's a party! Use the happy face and heart stamps on this page. (*Pause.*) Fantastic!

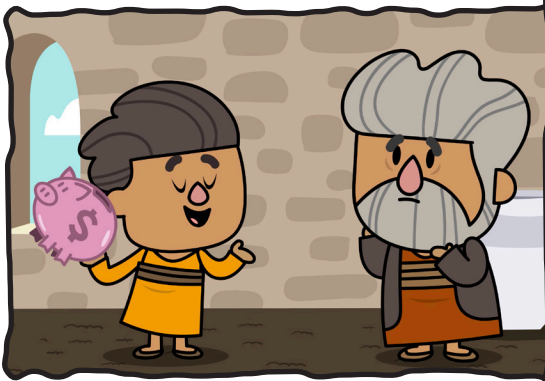

Oh no! He had to get a job feeding pigs! (*Hold up the picture of the son feeding pigs.*) He was so hungry he almost ate the pig's food! Eek!

"The son went home and told his father he was sorry. When his father saw him, he ran to his son and hugged him tight. (*Hold up the picture of father and son hugging.*) The father gave him a special ring and clothes and even threw him a party because he was so happy he came home.

God loves us like the father loved his son! God loves you (*hold up a mirror in front of each child*) and you and you! And God wants us to share that love because God wants everyone to be a part of His kingdom. That means when you love others, **[Bottom Line] you can be part of God's kingdom.**"

Gather small groups of children around you at a table for toddler craft time. Depending on the size of your group, you June lead the craft two or three times. Not every child June want to participate in craft time. That's okay. Feel free to send home the craft materials for them to complete with their family.

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print "Big Hug Label" on label paper, one label per child. Write each child's name on their sentence strip.

During the Activity: Help children pick a color ink pad, press one hand on the ink pad at a time and press down on the cardstock. Clean hands after each handprint. After children have their handprints made, let them decorate the sentence strip with dot markers. Leader will cut out each child's handprints while they decorate. Add the label and glue each child's hands to the ends of their sentence strip.

What You Say:

During the Activity: "Today we are going to make a big hug! First, we need to make your handprints! Pick a color and I'll help you stamp your whole handprint! *(Cover one of the child's hands and press down on the cardstock.)* Hooray! Let's clean your hand and then we'll make your other handprint! *(Clean hand, cover the other hand in ink and press down on the cardstock. Make sure to write child's name on the paper.)* Now it's time to decorate this big strip of paper with the markers. *(Pause.)* Fantastic! Let's add this sticker – it says **[Bottom Line] You can be part of God's kingdom!** Now, let's add your handprints. *(Rub glue on the left end and add that handprint. Repeat on the right side.)* Great job!

"In our story, the son went far away from home and spent all his money. He didn't have money or food to eat so he went back home to tell his father he was sorry. When his father saw his son, he ran to him and gave him a great big hug! That's what you made today!

"God loves us like the father loved his son! God loves you and wants everyone to be a part of His kingdom. That means when you! **[Bottom Line] You can be part of God's kingdom."**

Gather children on a rug or in a specific area of the classroom to tell the story. Some children (especially the younger ones) June wander. That's okay. They're still listening and learning!

LEADER: "Hello, friends! I'm so happy to see you today. Come join me on the floor. Today's story from the Bible (*hold up the Bible*) is a story that Jesus told because Jesus (*draw a simple stick figure picture of Jesus*) wanted EVERYONE (*draw lots of circle faces – some happy, some sad, some straight faces*) to know that God loves them! (*Draw a large heart around the faces.*)

"Jesus told a story about a father (*draw a stick figure father*) and son. (*Draw a stick figure son.*) The son asked his father for a lot of money (*draw simple circle coins and dollar bills*) and left home. (*Draw a simple road with the son walking away from the father.*)

He spent his money on fancy clothes and fancy food (*draw simple but colorful fancy clothes and food.*) until he had no more money! Oh no! He had to get a job feeding pigs! (*A little farther down the road, draw the son with simple picture of pigs around.*) He was so hungry he almost ate the pig's food! Eek!

"The son went home and told his father he was sorry. (*Wrap the road back to the father and draw the son.*) When his father saw him, he ran to his son and hugged him tight. (*Draw a simple stick figure dad hugging the son.*) Then the father threw a party because he was so happy to have his son back home! (*Draw party hats on the father and son. Draw simple dots as confetti.*)

God loves us like the father loved his son! (*Draw a heart and fill it in.*) God loves you and you and you! And God wants us to share that love because God wants everyone to be a part of His kingdom. That means when you love others, **[Bottom Line] you can be part of God's kingdom.**"

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print "Paint the Pig" on cardstock, one per child. Write each child's name on their paper. Slide each child's paper into a bag.

During the Activity: Squirt a few drops of brown paint in the front of each bag. Encourage children to fill smash and smush the paint around. When finished, remove the picture and set aside to dry.

What You Say:

During the Activity: "In our story, we learned that after the son spent all his money, he worked feeding pigs! Let's make our own piggy picture. (*Squirt some paint in front of the picture in each child's bag.*) Pigs love mud. Squish and squash the paint around your pig. (*Pause.*) Great job! (*Remove child's picture from the bag and throw the bag away.*) Look how muddy you made your pig! (*Hold up child's picture then set aside.*) When the son was feeding the pigs, he was so hungry. He almost ate the pig's food, oh no! That's when he decided to go back home and tell his father he was sorry! When his father saw him, he ran and hugged him. He was so happy his son was home!

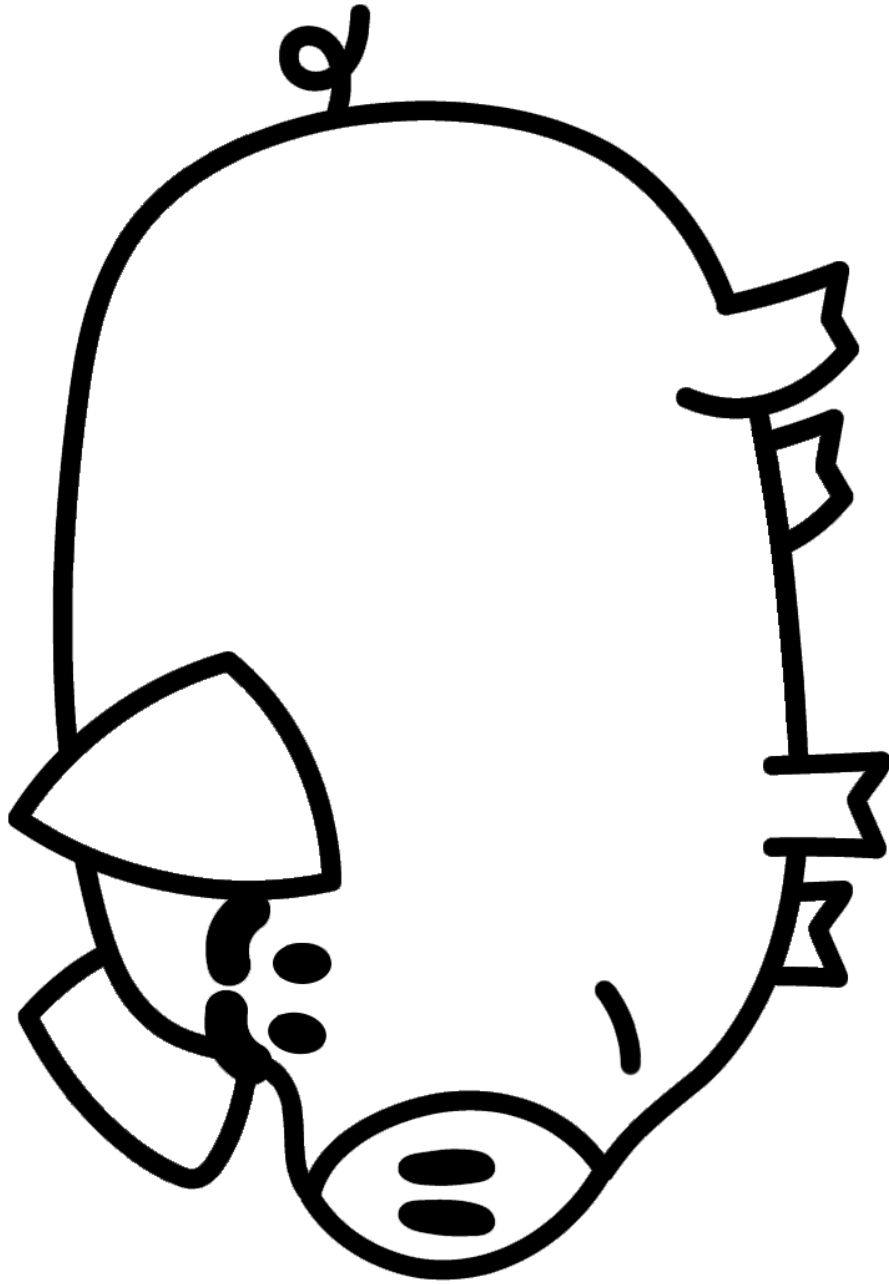

Oh no! He had to get a job feeding pigs and he almost ate the pig's food because he was so hungry! Eek!

"The son knew he was wrong, so he went home and told his father he was sorry. (*Walk the son figure back towards you and bring out the father people figure.*) His father ran to him and hugged him tight. (*Move the father to the son.*) The father gave him a special ring and clothes and even threw him a party (*toss some streamers in the air and blow the party horn*) because he was so happy he came home.

God loves us like the father loved his son! God loves you (*point to each child*) and you and you! And God wants us to share that love because God wants everyone to be a part of His kingdom. That means when you love others, **[Bottom Line] you can be part of God's kingdom.**"
