> Point to yourself with both hands.

LEADER: "Because God is with me!"

"Oh, that was awesome! Let's do that again.

Everyone, say, 'Oh no!'

CHILDREN and LEADER: "Oh, no!"

LEADER: "The king didn't know Esther was a part of God's people.

Everyone, say a really BIG "Oh, no!"

CHILDREN and LEADER: "Oh, no!"

SLIDE → Story Image W1 03

LEADER: "Esther knew she needed to talk to the king. There was just one problem.

> Take a deep breath and exhale.

"Esther needed to be...

> Pose like a superhero.

"BRAVE.

"So, Esther asked God's people to pray and talk to God with her. And they did! They prayed for three days!

"Count to three with me.

→ Hold up fingers as you count.

CHILDREN and LEADER: "One...two...three!

LEADER: "After Esther and God's people prayed, Esther trusted that God could help her be brave, and she went to the king.

"What do you think the king did when he saw Esther? Do you think the king let Esther talk to him?

"Give me a thumbs-up if you think the king will say, 'Yes.'

→ Hold two thumbs up.

"Give me a thumbs down if you think the king will say, 'No.'

> Hold two thumbs down.

"Well, the king ... said ...

→ Hold two thumbs up.

"YES!

"Yay! (CLAPS.) Queen Esther was brave and asked the king to keep God's people safe, and the king said yes!

Everyone, celebrated. Let's celebrate too!

→ Do the ASL sign for "applause": Hold open hands up and twist hands at wrists. See an example on Pinterest: pin.it/3WjqLFNDI

Say: "Hooray!"

CHILDREN and LEADER: Hooray!

LEADER: "Wow! Esther prayed, and God helped her be brave. And do you know what?

"You can pray, and God can help you be brave too! That's why when I ask, who can help you be brave, I want everyone to say, [BOTTOM LINE] God can help me be brave! Ready? Who can help you be brave?

CHILDREN and LEADER: [BOTTOM LINE] "God can help me be brave!

LEADER: "Yes, God can help you be brave, and [BOTTOM LINE] God can help me be brave!"

→ Pick up and close Bible.

[TRANSITION] "Our story time is over (PICK UP AND CLOSE BIBLE), but we're not through. Let's talk to God because God loves you!"

3 Prayer

LEADER: "Dear God, Thank You for hearing us when we pray to You. Help us remember that we can talk to You when we have hard things to do, and You will help us be brave. In Jesus' name. Amen.

"There is another man in this story...another BIG man. His name is Goliath. Can you say 'Goliath?'

→ Stomp your feet several times.

"Stomp, stomp, and stop. You can sit down now.

SLIDE → Story Image W2 02

"Goliath was bigger and tougher than all the other people, and every day, Goliath would shout to God's army in his big, giant voice.

(IN A BIG BOOMING VOICE.) Who's going to face me?"

When God's army heard Goliath, no one would say anything because they were SO afraid! No one was brave enough to face Goliath.

"That is, until David came to the field where God's army was. David heard Goliath yelling.

(IN A BIG BOOMING VOICE) Who's going to face me?

"David looked at God's army and saw how afraid they were. David was surprised that no one was brave enough to face Goliath.

"So, David said, 'I'll do it!'

"David was ready to be super brave because David knew God was with him. It didn't matter how big and tall Goliath was. David knew that God is bigger! And that made David super brave!

→ Pose like a superhero.

"Now, when King Saul saw David, he said, 'You can't fight big, tall Goliath! You're too small!'

"But David knew that God was with him, and God would help him be brave!

SLIDE → Story Image W2 03

"So, young David went out to face big, tall Goliath. Goliath was angry when he saw young David walking out to him, but David was brave! David looked at Goliath and said...

"You come at me with all your big weapons, but GOD is with me!"

"Then David took one stone, put it in his sling, and threw the stone as hard as he could! One ... two ... three!

> Pretend to sling a stone at Goliath.

"The stone flew through the air and hit Goliath in the middle of his forehead! And big, tall Goliath fell down on the ground!

SLIDE → Story Image W2 04

"Woo hoo! David did it! God helped David be brave! God was always with David, and God helped David be brave!

Do you think God can help you be brave too? (PAUSE.) Yes!

[BOTTOM LINE] God can help me be brave, and God can help YOU be brave!

Everyone, stand up and make a Super Kid pose!

→ Pose like a superhero.

Tell me: Who can help you be brave?

CHILDREN and LEADER: [BOTTOM LINE] "God can help me be brave!"

LEADER: can God help you be brave at school?

CHILDREN and LEADER: "YES!

LEADER: "Can God help you be brave when you meet new people?

CHILDREN and LEADER: "YES!

LEADER: "Can God help you be brave at the doctor's office?

> Motion for everyone to sit down.

→ Make an afraid face.

"Yeah, I feel afraid sometimes. Do you want to know what I do when I'm afraid? (LISTEN.) I remember that God is with me.

"The Bible teaches us that God is with us wherever we go. (DEUTERONOMY 31:6) So, if I'm happy...

→ Make a happy face.

"God is with me! If I'm afraid ...

→ Make an afraid face.

"God is with me! And no matter what you feel, God is with you too!

"So, let's stand up and sing to celebrate our God!

→ Lead children in singing "Super Duper Kid.

"Gideon was hiding in a hole. Gideon was hiding because Gideon was afraid. In fact, all of God's people were hiding because they were afraid too.

"You see, there was a BIG army called the Midianites! Show me your big muscles.
