



## Hello!

We are excited that your child is coming to Camp Wawona this summer! We'll be sending you more information as the summer gets closer, but here are a few things you'll want to keep in mind.

### Forms to be Completed



If you haven't already, you'll need to complete the following forms before you get here. You'll find them on your online account.

1. Camper Health History
2. Consent for Medical Treatment
3. Acknowledgment of Risks
4. Picture-Video Release
5. Violence & Graffiti Policy and Waiver

Finishing these before you arrive at camp ensures a smooth registration process upon arrival.

### Check In

Check in takes place between 2:00 – 5:00pm on Sunday. Any outstanding balance will be due upon arrival, as well as any uncompleted forms.

### Pick Up

Pick up will be between 9:00 – 11:00am on the following Sunday. Campers must be picked up by an individual on the authorized pick up list, which can be edited on your online account. For your child's safety, Camp Wawona will not release any camper to anyone who is not on this list. To pick up a camper, the individual **must show proper ID**. Unless prior arrangements have been made, **\$15 per hour will be charged after 11:00am until the camper is picked up**.

### Transportation Service

Camp Wawona offers round trip transportation services from three locations: Campbell, Casa de Fruta, and near Fresno. You can purchase this service through your online account. You can find information regarding pick-up times and locations on our website. Our maximum bus capacity is 20 campers



## Medical Team

Camp Wawona is blessed to have an outstanding team of medical professionals with us each week, consisting of a medical provider and at least two nurses. You can rest assured that your campers will be well taken care of during their stay at camp.

## Medications

Camp Wawona's Medical Team will be responsible for distributing all medications. Any medications must be given to the medical team upon check in. Please note that medications must be in their original containers. **Camp Wawona cannot distribute any medications that are not in their original containers.** In addition, **Camp Wawona cannot distribute any vitamins or natural remedies, so please leave these at home.**

Camp Wawona serves delicious vegetarian meals. Our Food Service Director along with his team of food service specialists, will be providing a variety of cuisine that we're confident your camper will enjoy!
