# Preschool – Fall Unit "God Gives Moses the Ten Commandments"

Bible Verse: "We must obey God" Acts 5:29

Music Time:

#### Lesson Time (w/flannel board)

(place Moses on the board) Moses was the leader of God's people. God said "Moses, lead the people out of Israel. The will be my special people!"

Moses obeyed and soon all the people started walking to a new land (place people on board – have children stand and walk in place). Can you pretend to walk with the Israelites?

The Israelites needed to learn how God wanted them to act. God told Moses to climb a tall mountain (place mountain on board). Can you pretend to climb a tall mountain? God wanted Moses to climb the tall mountain so he could give Moses a message to share with his people.

Moses walked down the mountain (can you walk down the mountain?). Moses told the people "God will give us His rules" and the Israelites said "We will obey!".

So Moses climbed back up the mountain (pretend you are climbing up the mountain). God gave Moses the Ten Commandments (rules) for his people to obey. God wrote the rules on stone tablets. Place ten commandments on the board.

Count with me as I say the ten rules God gave:

- 1. Do not love any person more than God.
- 2. Do not love anything more than God.
- 3. Say God's name nicely.
- 4. Rest and go to church on God's day
- 5. Love and obey your mommy and daddy
- 6. Do not kill anyone
- 7. Do not love someone else's husband or wife
- 8. Do not take anything that belongs to someone else
- 9. Do not tell lies
- 10. Do not want what belongs to someone else

God is glad when we obey Him. Can you say "we will obey God" (have children repeat it)

# **Coloring**

Take the children to the table and give them a few minutes to color the coloring page.

Take this time to help the kids repeat this week's memory verse a few times. Be sure to help the kids write their names on their papers and remind them to take them home with them.

## "I Will Obey" - Follow the Leader

Place posters around the room. Instruct kids to follow you from one to the other in order. As you arrive at each poster, read it out loud and then have the children say "I will obey" before you go to the next one. Make it fun by having the children follow you as you walk in circles, hip, etc to get from one poster to the next.
