



Assistant Pastor for College Ministry Position Description

Covenant Presbyterian Church (EPC) of Monroe, Louisiana is seeking a full-time Assistant Pastor for College Ministry, whose primary responsibility will be to lead the Covenant community in reaching students at the University of Louisiana Monroe (ULM), integrating students into the life of the church and shepherding them to be lifelong followers of Jesus Christ. This ministry will be developed in coordination with the College Ministry Team and will be intentionally Reformed in nature, encouraging students to place their faith in Jesus Christ, worship and serve Him in every aspect of their lives, and live out their faith in the context of the local church. The outreach to ULM will be characterized by a passionate sharing of the Gospel, sound biblical teaching, and a relational winsomeness. ULM is not simply a regional college but attracts students from all over the United States and the world. Therefore, the harvest field is both broad and ripe.

Responsibilities will include (but not limited to):

- Engage the mission field of the University of Louisiana Monroe by serving with a consistent presence on campus – reaching out to students, staff, and faculty alike to share the love and grace of God through the Gospel of Jesus Christ
- Develop strategic, Gospel-driven relationships with faculty and campus administrators as a way to reach the ULM community in a holistic way
- Develop and promote a Reformed theological presence on the campus of ULM
- Develop and provide leadership for a College Ministry Team while seeking to further encourage and promote participation from church members
- Disciple students with the goal of developing disciples who are equipped to disciple others
- Develop opportunities for discipleship and fellowship for college students
- Encourage student participation in the life of the church, especially in worship, Sunday school, small groups, and missions
- Make campus ministry opportunities visible and accessible to the congregation and actively find and offer opportunities for congregational engagement
- Encourage and equip members of the congregation to pursue and develop healthy biblical relationships with the college students

Qualifications:

- Christ-centered and Gospel-focused
- A strong sense of call to reach and disciple college students
- A vision and passion for the integration of college students into the life of the church

- A commitment to the Reformed faith, especially as expressed in the Westminster Confession of Faith and Catechisms
- Fully affirm and be committed to minister pursuant to the EPC “Essentials of Our Faith.”
- Spirit-led self-starter capable of starting new ministries, while also having a willingness and ability to be a team player
- Gifted as a communicator and evangelist
- Master of Divinity Degree (M.Div.) from an accredited seminary
- Ordained or able to be ordained in the Evangelical Presbyterian Church
- Experience in college ministry, small group discipleship, leadership development, and evangelism encouraged
