Blending the rich traditions of jazz with the rhythmic vitality of funk, soulfulness of R&B, and depth of blues, the ensemble cultivates a sound that is both distinctive and compelling.



BELLARMINES UNIVERSITY JAZZ FACULTY

Bellarmine University was the first university in Louisville to offer a music degree with a jazz emphasis. For 50 years, Bellarmine has been graduating top notch jazz musicians, none of which would be possible without a top notch jazz faculty, each of whom is an accomplished musician and a vital part of the local and regional jazz scene: Andy Oberhausen on alto saxophone, Todd Hildreth on piano, Danny Kiely on bass, and Terry O'Mahoney on the drums. Each has not only played in a variety of situations, but has honed a sound of his own through many performances as a unit.



BRAZUKAS

Brazukas is an authentic, completely Brazilian rhythm section hailing from various regions of Brazil. Experience music in your favorite Brazilian styles, such as Bossa Nova and Samba, and music in the traditional and modern Brazilian styles rarely played in the U.S., such as Baiao, Ljexa, Choro, and Partido-Alto.
