

FAITH COMMUNITY BIBLE CHURCH AND COVID 19

What a blessing it has been to gather together as a church community.

Please do not attend if you are ill, experiencing symptoms, or especially at-risk to COVID-19 infection or transmission. Here are some questions we would ask you to prayerfully consider before coming. If the answer is “yes” to any of the following questions, you may be at risk of transmitting coronavirus.

- Have you traveled out of the country in the last 14 days?
- Have you had contact with (been within 6') of anyone who has lab confirmed coronavirus (SARS COV-2) within 14 days of symptom onset?
- In the last two weeks, did you care for or have close contact with someone diagnosed with the coronavirus?
- In the last two weeks have you worked or volunteered in a healthcare facility?
- Did you wear all recommended personal protective equipment while you were in close contact with someone diagnosed with the coronavirus? If no, you may be at risk of transmitting the coronavirus.

In the last 48 hours, have you had any of the following NEW symptoms?

- Fever (>99.6 F) or history of fever within the last 14 days?
- Chills
- Sore throat
- Shortness of breath/chest tightness
- Loss of Taste or Smell
- Runny Nose
- Nasal Congestion
- Headache
- Fatigue/exhaustion
- Muscle aches
- Nausea/Vomiting/Diarrhea

If the answer is “yes” to any of the following, you may be at an increased risk of severe illness if you contract the coronavirus.

Are you 65 years old or older?

- Do you have any of the following underlying medical conditions?
- Chronic lung disease or moderate to severe asthma
- Heart conditions
- Obesity (BMI >40)
- Diabetes
- Chronic Kidney Disease
- Liver Disease

Are you immunocompromised?

- Many conditions can cause a person to be immunocompromised, including cancer treatment, smoking, bone marrow or organ transplantation, immune deficiencies, poorly controlled HIV or AIDS, and prolonged use of corticosteroids and other immune weakening medications.
