Please label all personal items with your child's name. Some supplies will be provided by the teacher or school to ensure consistency and support student success. If an item is lost or mistreated beyond reuse, families may be asked to send a replacement.

Provided by Teacher or School

- 1 Homework Folder: (includes important papers such as homework, study guides, newsletters, etc.)
- 1 Writing Folder: (includes writing checklists, drafting space, and revision tools)
- 1 Hard-sided pencil box: (standard size to fit inside student desks)
- 1 Spelling notebook: (used weekly for phonograms and spelling lists)
- 1 Student Planner: (used for daily communication and organization)
- Whiteboards and erasers (for classroom use)

Items to Provide From Home

Folders & Notebooks

- 1 plastic folder with pockets (sturdy, solid color)
 - → For unfinished work and reference materials
- 1 wide-ruled composition notebook
 - → For morning work, journaling, and Bible reflections
- 1 wide-ruled spiral notebook
 - → For grammar and classroom notes

Writing & Art Supplies

- 1 dozen sharpened #2 pencils
- 2 red pens or Flair-style writing markers
- Several highlighters (3–4)
- 2 block erasers
- 1 box of Crayola crayons (24 count)
- 1 box of Crayola markers (8–12 count)

**Optional: If your child prefers colored pencils, please include a personal sharpener (or use Twistables). Traditional colored pencils often clog classroom sharpeners.*

- 10 glue sticks
- 1 small bottle of white glue
- 1 pair of kid-sized scissors

Technology

- 1 pair of large, wired, over-ear headphones
 - → Labeled and stored in a zip-top bag

Classroom Care

- 3 rectangular boxes of facial tissues (no cube-shaped boxes)
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 6 containers of disinfecting wipes (3 for now, 3 for later in the year)

Additional Personal Items

- 1 pair of gym shoes (to be kept at school for PE)
- 1 reusable water bottle (spill-proof and labeled)
