Dear Parents,

Thank you again for the privilege of teaching your children. They are such gifts! We have had fun this past month learning about nutritious foods and eating healthy. We have also studied numbers 1-6. We will continue working on our numbers through December. Any practice writing their numbers at home would be great!

We have important dates on our calendar. We will have Christmas parties in our classroom on Monday, **Dec. 17<sup>th</sup>** and Tuesday, **Dec. 18<sup>th</sup>**. Our Christmas programs will be **Dec. 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>**.

Please bring the morning students to our room no earlier than 8:50 a.m. and the afternoon students no earlier than 1:50 p.m. We do not require the students to dress up for their program, but many of them choose to do so and that is perfectly fine! Grandparents and others are welcome to attend!

We will take a free will offering during the program to help purchase new toys for our classroom. The program will last about twenty minutes and will be followed by a refreshment time. You may then take your child home. This will be the last day of preschool before Christmas vacation. Classes will resume January 3<sup>rd</sup>.
