Dear Parents,

Greetings and great job on the homework! It is so fun to see the enthusiasm that the students have regarding their assignments!

This month we will be having Valentine's Day **PARTIES** in our classroom **Wednesday, Feb. 13<sup>th</sup>** and **Thursday, Feb. 14<sup>th</sup>**. This creates a huge opportunity for your child to master writing his or her name. We ask that you have your child sign his or her name on the back of 24 Valentine cards (which will be their homework that week). Feel free to help if they get tired. I found that with my own children just writing out a few a day made the task much more enjoyable ☺. You may also add candy or gum to the Valentines if you wish. Do not address the envelopes; it makes it much easier to pass out this way. The Valentine cards may be brought to school on Monday, Feb. 11<sup>th</sup> or Tuesday, Feb. 12<sup>th</sup>. We will make Valentine bags to put them in during class.

This month we will also continue working hard on our alphabet. We have a special "visitor" each day who tells us about the letter we are learning. Feel free to "quiz" your child on letters A-G! Students are encouraged to be able to recognize all capital letters, count 1-20 and write their name upon entering kindergarten at most schools. Our special unit for the month will be "All About Me", a science unit emphasizing how we are all 'fearfully and wonderfully made' in God's image. We will study the five senses, what it means to keep our bodies healthy as well as celebrate our similarities and our differences.

As usual, we are experiencing a very high demand and we will be opening enrollment to the general public February 1<sup>st</sup>.
