### Frequently Asked Questions:

#### How long is the internship?

- The training program lasts for one year; May 31st 2019 to May 22nd, 2020
- We have a required off campus training retreat & orientation for incoming student volunteers May 31st 2019 to June 7th 2019. We will spend the first three days at Camp Comanche in Eastern PA.

#### What is the placement process of interns?

- Based on the evaluation of applications and interviews, student volunteers will be placed in positions where the need and interests coincide.

#### How many hours do student volunteers serve each week?

\*These hours will not include the New York School of the Bible courses and NYC training courses that our student volunteers need to take a lead on our outreach programs and events.\*

- *Full time J.J.D. Hall Student Volunteers: 33 - 35 hours a week*
- *Collaborative Student Volunteers (TSC Interns): 15 – 20 hours a week*

#### Is housing provided?

- We offer housing at our mission house, dorm style. We ask our student volunteers to raise support in order to help with costs of utilities. This comes in form of a \$500.00 gift to be given to the ministry on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month. NOTE: THIS IS NOT RENT. \*This is also due to change.\*

#### Is health/dental insurance provided?

- Responsibility of health and dental insurance falls on the student volunteer. Student volunteers under 25 years old can qualify to be covered by their parents' policies.

#### Do interns receive vacation time?

- All interns will be given vacation time for Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's. Once schedules are set, discussions with more specific details will be held.

**Do interns get to go on a short-term missions trip?**

- Yes. J.J.D. Hall student volunteers will need to raise their own support for the trip expenses on any of the short terms mission trips with either:
  - Local missions: Camp Comanche in Jermyn, Pennsylvania.
  - Global missions: Casa de Dios Y Puerta del Cielo Ministry in Dominican Republic.

**Are interns required to attend a church?**

- Student volunteers are expected and required to find a home church to attend weekly. Some churches that we recommend (but limited to,) are:
  - Times Square Church
  - Calvary Baptist Church
  - New Life Fellowship
  - Redeemer Church
  - Trinity Baptist Church
  - Remnant Church
  - Church of the City

**Can the training program be extended for a second year?**

- If a student volunteer shows interest in interning for another year, they would need to discuss it with staff, and apply again.
- *Another year is not guaranteed because our goal is to be a stepping-stone for believers and encourage interns to go forth and spread the Good News of Christ with the experience they have learned at St. Paul's House.*
