START

READ

[2 Chronicles 34:3](#) In the eighth year of his reign, while he was still young, he began to seek the God of his father David.

[1 Chronicles 28:8](#) "So now I charge you in the sight of all Israel and of the assembly of the Lord, and in the hearing of our God: Be careful to follow all the commands of the Lord your God, that you may possess this good land and pass it on as an inheritance to your descendants forever."

THINK

- In the message, Chris asked this question: "What does it mean to seek God?" Please share.
- *"Everyone has a story. Every story has the potential to be Epic if God is the hero."* Who is the hero of your story? How is God the Hero of your Story? And in what ways do you make yourself the hero?
- David made it a point to encourage all of Israel to "pass it on as an inheritance" for generations to come. Share different ways you are (or you can) doing this.

PRAY

Invite God in to be the Hero of your story and be transparent about your desire to be autonomous and unaccountable. Surrender this to God.

ACT

This week keep focused on God being the Hero of your story. Pay attention to the subtle moments throughout the week where your desire to be *king* rises up.
