

PART 2: The Call to Action **DATE: 05-20-2018**

START

Everyone is on a spiritual journey filled with moments of discovery, new insights, and the realization that we all have so many areas to grow in. Share about a person that has had the most significant impact on your life.

READ

[2 Chronicles 34:3-4](#) In his twelfth year, he began to purge Judah and Jerusalem of high places, Asherah poles, and idols. Under his direction the altars of the Baals were torn down; he cut to pieces the incense altars that were above them and smashed the Asherah poles and the idols.

[2 Kings 23:2-3](#) He read in their hearing all the words of the Book of the Covenant, which had been found in the temple of the Lord. The king stood by the pillar and renewed the covenant in the presence of the Lord—to follow the Lord and keep his commands, statutes, and decrees with all his heart and all his soul, thus confirming the words of the covenant written in this book. Then all the people pledged themselves to the covenant.

THINK

Josiah's spiritual journey had several significant moments from seeking God to purging items that went against God's heart. Share a moment in your spiritual journey that was significant in your spiritual growth.

In the message, Chris made the statement: ***Live in the culture without the culture living in you.***

PRAY

Ask God to reveal to you any things in your life that go against His plan for your life. Invite God to help you see what you need to see and to give you the strength and wisdom to overcome those specific areas.

ACT

This week keep focused on God being the Hero of your story. Pay attention to the areas that culture is trying to take your focus off of God. Commit to being hyper-focused on purging those things from your life.
