START

[2 Timothy 4:6-7](#) For I am already being poured out like a drink offering, and the time for my departure is near. 7 I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith

THINK

There are three key insights that Chris pulled out of 2 Chronicles 35:22. 1) Pride shoves God out and crowns you King. 2) God won't guide what you choose to hide. 3) God is speaking. Are you listening?

- Out of these 3 insights, what one do you need to focus on in this season?
- God is constantly speaking truth to you and guiding your path. What is God saying to you right now?
