



## DISCUSSION GUIDE

### START:

- A motivational poster once said “Live life to the fullest because it only happens once.” What steps would you like to take, “to live life to its fullest” in 2018?

### THINK:

- Think of the people around you; the people that surround you where you live, where you work, and where you play. What would they say a “life lived to its fullest” looks like? What do you think one looks like?
- Read John 8:12. Jesus explains that He is the light of the world. We’ve talked a lot about darkness and light in the last 2 weeks, what do you think a “life lived to its fullest” *in the light of Jesus* could look like?
- Read John 10:10. How would a “life lived to its fullest” through Jesus compare to what others around you think a “life lived to its fullest” looks like? How are they similar? How are they different?

### PRAY:

- This week, ask God to help you continue to move further into the light that is Jesus. Then, ask Him to show you how you can help others around you move into that light in the year ahead.

### ACT:

- Continue to commit to moving toward the light that is Jesus. As you do, continue to be open to help from others who on the same journey.
- Think about the people who surround you: where you live, where you work, where you play. Prayerfully consider how you can show the light of Jesus to them in the coming year.

### READ:

*When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.”* **John 8:12**

*The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.* **John 10:10**
