 Message: **To The Limit**



DISCUSSION GUIDE

START:

- Think back to your 1st real paying job. What was it? How did you feel making money for the 1st time? Did you feel like you had margin?

THINK:

- Read Matthew 6:19-21. Jesus tells us to “treasure” the right things.
- What do “treasures” here on earth look like? What are some things that are *your* earthly “treasures”?
- What does “treasure” in heaven look like? It looks a lot like caring, serving, and giving. It looks a lot like love. In what ways does your life show these 3 things? In what ways does your life show this kind of love?

PRAY:

- Ask God to help you search your heart this week and examine your attitudes and thoughts on money. Ask Him to show you how you can adjust your attitudes and actions in this arena. Finally, ask Him to provide you someone you can confide in to help.

ACT:

- Reflect on your thought patterns regarding money. Think about who you know that you believe is “rich”. Do you envy them? Even just a little? Do you compare yourself to them? Think about how much more income you would need for “everything to be ok”. What % or amount extra would that be?
- Ask yourself this question: “Who is my real master, God or money?” As you consider your answer, think about these questions:
 - How many clothes or shoes do you have in your closet that you never wear?
 - How much credit card debt do you have?
 - How much do you give – no strings attached – a year? (Do you even know?)
 - When was the last time you gave – to the point it hurts?
- As you consider the answer to these questions, decide who your master will be. Then, determine how you can allocate your income in a way that “stores treasure in heaven”.

READ:

¹⁹ “Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. ²⁰ But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. ²¹ For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.
