

DISCUSSION GUIDE

PART 1: Direct and Protect DATE: 07-08-2018

START

There are three words when put together that have the potential to lead to a lot of trouble...I DARE YOU! These words are strung together in our culture often to encourage one another to cross "painted lines."

- What's the dumbest thing you have done because of a dare? What's the dumbest thing you have dared someone to do?
- Looking back, how wise was your decision to follow through with the dare?
- Do the people you spend the most time with now make wise decisions?
- Are the people you spend time with now surrounded by wise people?

READ

Ephesians 5:15-17

Be very careful, then, how you live - not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is.

THINK

Wise people surround themselves with wise people. Fools (or unwise) surround themselves with fools. There are two simple and pointed questions to help discern if a person is "wise": 1) Does the person make wise decisions? 2) Is the person surrounded by wise people?

• Who do you have in your life that is helping you build and stay between guardrails?

Chris said, "Guardrails are not about becoming better people, but surrendered people."

- What do you feel when you hear the word surrender?
- Do you find it hard to surrender to God?
- What in your life are you trying to control that needs to be surrendered?
- How can we as a church be a light to those that need to surrender?

PRAY

Thank God for being a loving God and for knowing what is best for us. Ask God to take control of the things that you need to surrender to Him.

ACT

This week take the necessary steps to surrender whatever you're holding onto to God, and make a commitment to leave a light on for those in your life that need a safe place to come and surrender to God.
