START

- Have you ever had a time when you thought you knew the lyrics to a popular song, only to find out that you were really wrong? What was the song? What was it that you thought the lyrics said? What did they actually say?

READ

- “Therefore everyone who **hears these words of mine and puts them into practice** is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. But everyone **who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice** is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash.”

THINK

- Last week, many people wrote down the things in their life that seem insurmountable on the **Insurmountable Wall** at their campus. It was a way to commit that situation, circumstance, or obstacle to God. Have you surrendered the things that seem insurmountable in your life to God?
- In this week’s message Chris shared 4 phrases that people think are part of God’s word but really are not in the Bible. Did any of those stand out to you? Are there any other ideas, teaching, or phrases you thought were part of God’s word, only to find out later that they were not?
- Read Matthew 7:24-27. What things get in the way of you being able to **hear** God’s word? What can you do to overcome them?
- What gets in the way of you putting God’s word into practice?

PRAY

- Ask God to help you find the time to read His word, the wisdom to know what it says, and the strength to live it out.

ACT

- In this week’s message, Chris mentions that in Matthew Chapters [5](#), [6](#), & [7](#) Jesus presents some of the most simple and practical guidance ever shared in regards to our relationship to God and to one another. Take some time to read these chapters this week and ask yourself: which parts of the teaching do you live out, and which parts do you struggle with? How can this group help you?
