PART 3 : Known Survivor    DATE: 03-25-2018

## START

- At the end of your life, what would you most like to be known for? Why do you want to be known for that thing?

## READ

- The next day John was there again with two of his disciples. When he saw Jesus passing by, he said, "Look, the Lamb of God!" [John 1: 35-36](#)
- "He must become greater; I must become less." [John 3:30](#)

## THINK

- What are some ways the appetite for being known is reflected in our cultural values?
- From what audience do you most hunger for applause—your friends, your spouse, your children, your parents, your boss, your peers? How does that hunger drive your behavior and decision-making?
- Read John 1: 35-36. John the Baptist saw his role as pointing others to Jesus. For John, the most important thing was making Jesus known. Do others see Jesus through your actions and your life?
- Read John 3:30. In what ways do you need to "become less" so Jesus can "become greater" in your life? What are some obstacles to that happening?

## PRAY

- Ask God to show you 1 way that you can "become less" so that Jesus can "become greater" in your life.

## ACT

- Doing your best with what you've been given, working hard, striving for excellence: all of this honors God. But in the end, **remember who it's from and who it's for.** Ultimately, it's only God's applause that matters.
- What is one thing you can do this week to stop seeking the applause of other people and begin to listen to the applause of your heavenly Father? How can this group help you follow through?
