### **Genesis - In the Beginning**

**Big Idea of the Series:** Genesis is the story of God creating and bringing order and function into the earth, the rebellion of humanity against divine authority, and God's unfolding plan to restore creation and humankind to his original purposes through grace and faith. Genesis 1–11 tells of God and his relationship to the entire world, while Genesis 12–50 describes God's relation to Abraham and his descendants.

January 7

Text: Genesis 1-2

**Big Idea of the Message**: There is one true God and he is the author of all creation. God brings order, function, and beauty out of the dark, watery chaos by creating a magnificent garden and creating humankind in his image. We are called to reflect the Creator's creativity, goodness, and character in the world.

January 14

Text: Genesis 3-4

**Topic**: Temptation, Sin, Redemption

**Big Idea of the Message**: As Adam and Eve carry out God's mandate for the earth, Satan enters the story to entice the couple to humanity's original rebellion against God. When we lose the battle against temptation and sin, God continues to pursue us in his relentless love and always gives us the opportunity to confess and repent.

Text: Genesis 6-9

**Big Idea of the Message**: The story of the flood reveals a God who is both holy Judge and gracious Redeemer. Because God is our Redeemer, we can put our confidence in him and in his promises.




