Real Life Faith

This sermon series urges us away from projecting a filtered and curated version of our lives and our faith journeys. Whether it's from the fear of others, the shame of our shortcomings, or the fear of facing the truth, living through a false self can cripple our spiritual growth. We also deal with the hypocrisy and temptation of living in two worlds simultaneously: that of the church or Christian life and that of the normal life. We will discover whether it is possible to live in both or if we must choose to live in one or the other.

Jonah was living in denial of who God called him to be. Jonah's fear of facing the truth led him to run from God's presence and left him—like many Christians—in distress, desperately crying to God to save him. Real-life faith does not ignore, deny, or run from facing the reality of our circumstances. By bringing to God our motivations for living in denial, we can experience God's mercy and walk confidently into the plans he has for us.

June 11, 2023 - Part 4

Jesus calls His disciples to live out our faith by being salt and light to the world. Our saltiness and light should extend beyond our church life. To have Real Life Faith, believers must allow their faith to affect the rest of their life.



First United Methodist Church Covington is known throughout the county for it's food pantry. Serving anywhere between 300 and 400 households each month, the Food Pantry relies solely on volunteers to make the operation work. Collecting donations, sorting food, stocking the food pantry, bagging produce, bread, and canned goods, registering patrons, loading cars, and cleaning up are all jobs that are executed by volunteers.

Lately finding volunteers has been a challenge, and the summer months will prove to be even more difficult with families planning vacations and teenagers taking on summer jobs. We could use some extra help.

The Food Pantry operates every first and third Saturday of each month in Covington. Volunteers serve from 8:15 to 11:00 AM on those days. Very few of the volunteer jobs require any type of pre-training and can be learned on the job. Even signing up to volunteer is easy.
