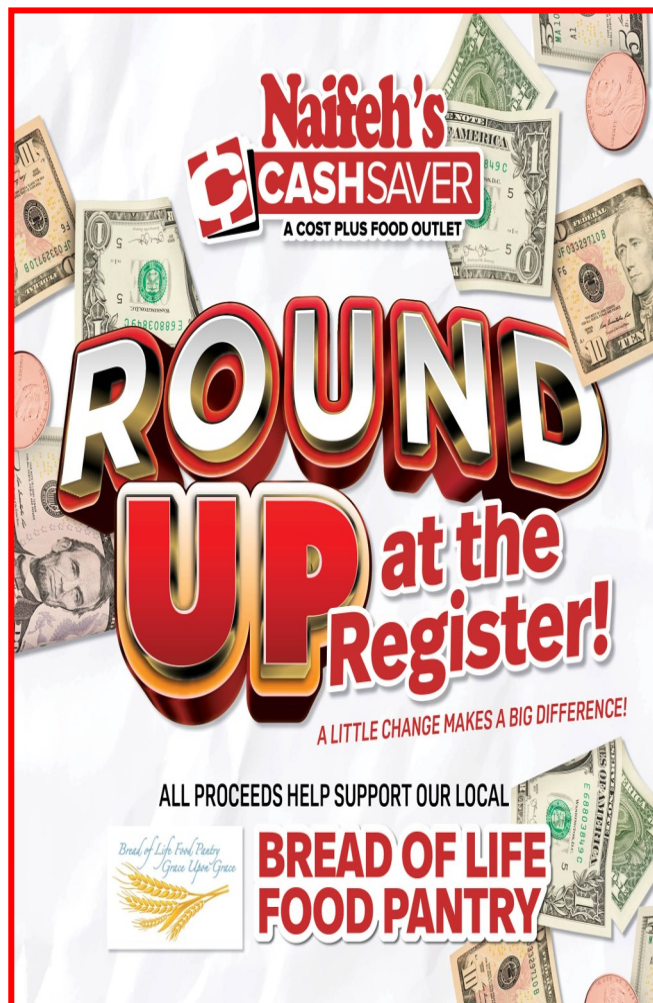

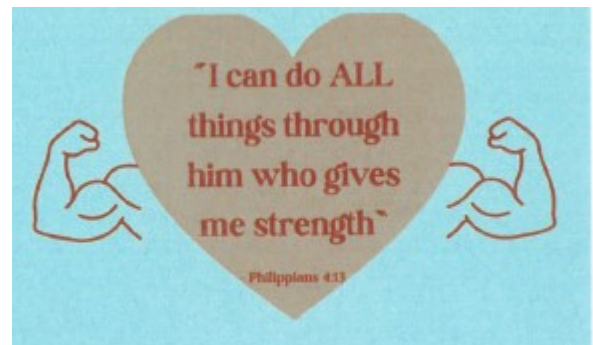
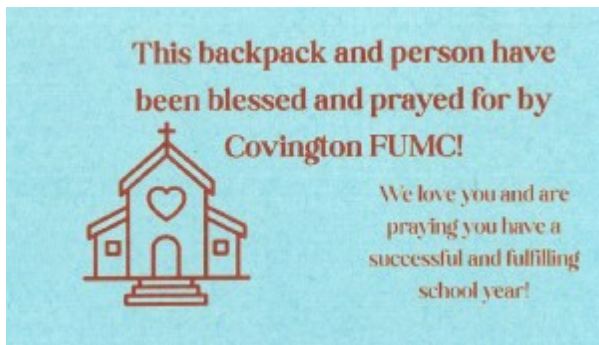


United Women in Faith
