Four Saturdays a month, each and every month of the year, the Bread of Life food Pantry opens it's doors to serve over 200 households in need in our community, feeding, on average, over 450 individuals each month. This is no small task, requiring volunteers from throughout the community pitching in not only on Saturday mornings, but throughout the week as well.

Monday, Wednesday, and Friday mornings volunteers are picking up donated food items from local businesses, at least once a month volunteers are making the trip to Memphis to pickup the Food Bank orders, and there will be volunteers back

at the church to unload when they return. Twice a month volunteers gather on a Friday morning to pre-bag non-perishables in preparation for the upcoming pantry distribution. Periodically a group will meet to "double bag" or to bundle and label diapers. There is a lot of work that goes on prior to a Food Pantry Saturday and, of course, a lot of work on that day.

The Bread of Life Food Pantry is blessed with some of the most awesome and dedicated volunteers any organization could have! God continues to bless us with the ways and the means to continue the ministry of feeding the needy, sharing His love, and sharing the Word. 


