

# What To Bring List



- Sheets, pillows, blankets**
  - We will be sleeping in bunk beds (twin size).
  - You may want to bring a sleeping bag
- Towels** for showers and swimming
- Water bottle** you can refill and carry with you
- Closed toe, closed heel **shoes** (for outdoor activities)
- Bible, notepad, and pen** **\*\*DON'T FORGET YOUR BIBLE\*\***
- Toiletries** (toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, soap, shampoo, etc.)
- Sun protection**
- Flashlight**
- Summer clothing** (see dress code below)
- Spending money** for snacks, camp store, and missions offering (optional)
- Money** for FOUR TRAVEL MEALS (see travel schedule)
- FAN** if you wish. Housing is not air conditioned.
- Wrist WATCH**. You will not have our phone to keep track of the time.

## What NOT To Bring

- Alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, fireworks, water guns, or any kind of weapon.
- Knives of any kind.
- NO CELL PHONES**, iPads, iPods, Kindles, gaming devices, etc.
  - Bring an **alarm clock** if you need one.
- Items that may be used for pranks such as water balloons, shaving cream, silly string, etc. Pranks are not allowed at camp. You will be charged for any damages or issues related to clean up.

## Dress Code

### Do NOT pack anything that:

- Advertises alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs.
- Explicitly or implicitly promotes racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person.
  - Explicitly or implicitly refers to sexual actions or situations.
- **Has spaghetti/small straps or open back**, except for sleepwear.
- **Is excessively short or tight fitting.**

### While at camp, we ask that students:

- Wear sleeved t-shirts (**no tank-tops - even for the guys**) and modest shorts (when hands are extended to the back or the front, finger tips must touch fabric).
- Wear closed-toe and closed-heel shoes while at recreation and track times (and during Mega Relay).
- Wear modest, one-piece bathing suits or two-piece suits covered with a dark colored t-shirt, if participating in water activities.
- Wear modest shorts, pants, jeans, or dresses for worship. Dresses with spaghetti or small straps, open backs, and excessively short lengths are unacceptable (when hands are extended to the back or the front, finger tips must touch fabric).
- Do not dress in a way that calls attention to underwear (sagging your pants, rolling down your waistbands, etc.) or wear pants or shorts with lettering on the bottom.

### BASIC RULE:

*Just bring comfortable clothes that aren't inappropriate.*
